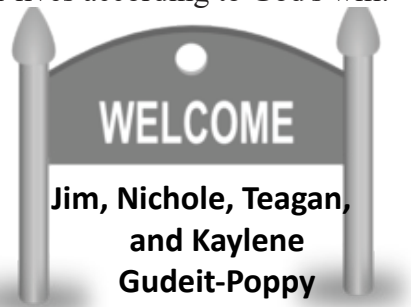

Paul goes on to explain that the body — the Church, our faith community — cannot function or survive without each member playing an active part.
