According to the story, an Anglican monk baked the buns and marked them with a cross in honor of Good Friday. Over time they gained popularity, and eventually became a symbol of Easter weekend.

Stations of the Cross



Join us in CHURCH for a "Walk with Jesus to Calvary" by praying the Stations of the Cross on this **Wednesday, April 17 at 6:30 p.m.** before the Triduum begins from sundown Holy Thursday to sundown Good Friday; sundown Good Friday to sundown Holy Saturday; Sundown Holy Saturday to sundown Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil. The liturgical services that take place during the Triduum are:
 Mass of the Lord's Supper
 Good Friday of the Lord's Passion
 Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord.

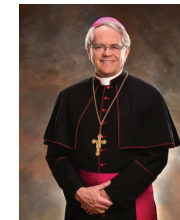
