To Mitigate the Coronavirus, the church and chapel will be closed to ALL services until further notice. In addition, the office door will remain locked with contact only by phone. If the phone goes to voicemail during the office hours, please leave a message. Your call is important to us; so rest assured we will get back to you as soon as we can.

We will continue to stay in constant contact with you through e-mails to keep you informed. If you are viewing this bulletin on the St. Andrew website, but haven't been receiving emails from us entitled *Staying Connected with Faith* please contact the parish office to update our records.

Reaching Out

While we are unable to physically meet or visit, this has not stopped so many of you from reaching out making calls and checking on neighbors and members of our community of St. Andrew, praying with them and for one another. The Outreach Phone Tree Team (19 team members) with guidance from Wayne and Marcia Kessler are making calls not only to those from our list of 100 families as a result of the census, but over 300+ registered families, some who have since moved away but many others who plan to complete a census form to update our records and be counted as a member of our loving and caring community.

In addition, Linda Lysakowski provided us with an update on how the ministry for the homebound, nursing home/long term care residents have been reaching out and making sure that they are not forgotten during this pandemic. Jennifer Tuggle and Linda Lysakowski have written note cards and mailed/delivered them to all those who have attended their communion services or received communion in their rooms each week at the Mountain View Care. In addition, Linda provided the facility with the link or her recording on Zoom for viewing the St. Andrew Sunday Masses/services OnLine. Last week the staff invited anyone to drive into their parking lot to smile and wave to the residents that they had assembled on the patio. Linda commented, "It was quite an event, they had hundreds of cars drive through. I invited and know that many were from St. Andrew. It even made local news." This is one example where not only St. Andrew but the local community has made sure that those who are trapped in isolation amid the coronavirus receive phone calls, cards or letters, and more to brighten their day.

Some other examples of the community reaching out:

- Lakeview Terrace has requested and received cards from the general public.
- Michael Greene and Allison Shafer have made sure cards and letters reach those at the Boulder City Hospital Long Term Care.
- Barbara Dempsey on the Outreach Calling Team is also staying in touch by phone with one resident at Homestead.
- Becky Trudeau has reached out to the Veterans Home to make sure that those who are visited by communion ministers/volunteers from St. Andrew are not forgotten either through delivery of note cards and/or making sure the facility has the link to our St. Andrew Masses/services OnLine.
- The ministers (9 Homebound Communion Ministers) who normally bring communion to the Homebound on Sunday have a Phone Tree set up and instead call those on their list each week and offer Spiritual Communion.

We are still looking for anyone who would like to write cards to the residents of the nursing homes or facilities. Please contact Linda Lysakowski at cylinda@cox.net or 702-580-1448 and she will see that they get distributed to the nursing homes or facilities that are allowing mail to be delivered or sent.
