Staying Connected

We will again gather at St. Andrew to celebrate Mass together as a community **next Sunday, July 5th at 8 AM, 10 AM, and 12 Noon**. Because we are still limited to 50 people (including ministers), we will again have a pre-registration system for members of our community to sign up online for a Mass. You will be sent an e-mail with the link again on Monday by noon. Registration will be on a first come, first serve basis. For those who do not use a computer, they will need to call the parish office each week to be signed up from the designated reserved seating.

We will continue to stay in constant contact with you through e-mails to keep you informed of any changes or adjustments in restrictions, protocols, and procedures as we transition into this "new normal." **Most importantly, the link to sign-up to register for a Mass at St. Andrew for you and each member of your family will be provided through these e-mails.** If you are viewing this bulletin on the St. Andrew website, but you haven't been receiving emails from us, please contact the parish office.

Mass Registration Helpful Hints

To help you through the sign-up or pre-registration for Mass:

- Pre-register for Masses online by clicking on the Mass Registration link sent to your email Monday morning at approximately 12 Noon.
- Click on the green Sign up box for the Mass desired. *(A check will appear in the small check-mark box).*
- If the Mass desired is filled, please consider the other available Mass options.
- As the demand increases another Mass will be added unless Phase Three re-opening plan is put into effect and the limit of 50 people is increased.
- Go down to the orange box labeled Submit and Sign-up.

Please do NOT click on any other boxes or messages on the screen.

Once you click on Submit and Sign-up you will be brought to Sign Me Up.

- Enter the number (if more than 1) in your party under quantity
- Type in your first and last name and your e-mail address
- Click on the Sign Up Now orange box. You will receive a message: Thank-you ___! You're all signed up for St. Andrew Catholic Community.
- Press the X at the top of your screen to close

No need to go Back to Sign-up

- Check your email for your confirmation (or more than one if there are more in your party).

If you decide that you want to cancel, change the quantity in your party, or go to another Mass time, you can make these changes from the Sign-up Confirmation e-mail. Just click on Edit My Sign Up.

To Cancel

Click on **Delete**

Change the Quantity

Select the new quantity and then click Click on **Update My Sign-up**. You will receive a message: Thank-you... Your sign-up is updated! Check your e-mail for your NEW confirmation.

Change to another Mass time

Check if the Mass desired is not filled.

Then, delete or cancel the **Mass you previously signed-up to attend** (small X in green box above the Mass's Sign-up green box). **Continue by following the steps above to sign-up for the Mass desired.**

Plans Changed

After receiving confirmation that you are all signed up to attend Mass, you find that your plans have changed and you will not be able to attend Mass after all at St. Andrew. Please access your Sign-up Confirmation e-mail and Cancel (Delete) the reservation as soon as you know. This will allow someone else an opportunity to attend Sunday Mass (especially, the 8 AM and 10 AM Masses as they are usually "filled").



RE-OPENING CHURCH "New Normal" GUIDELINES

ATTENDING MASS Guide

- **Pre-register for Masses online**
8 AM, 10 AM, or 12 PM
(non-computer users call office)
- **Wear Mask (10 yrs +)**
- **Bring own hand sanitizer**
- **Enter first through metal double-doors to parish hall**
(parking lot side)
- **Temperature checked before allowed to enter church**
(must be less than 100.4)

- Sanitize hands
- Check-in
- Proceed to church
 - Enter through the front doors of the church
 - Exit through the chapel/ the side church door
- Ushers will direct or seat you:
 - front rows to back
 - every other pew
- fill up available seats - go all the way to the end of the pew and fill inward and to the other end
- individuals, couples or a family must be 6 ft. apart from the next group or individual

(6 ft. apart markings on pews as a guide)

Please come early and allow extra time to be in the church on time.

(doors to hall open 30 minutes before Mass)

Once Mass begins, no one will be allowed to enter the parish hall or church.

COMMUNION PROCEDURES Guide

Added helpful hints for your review

Rather than starting with the back pews, as has been our custom at St. Andrew, we will begin from the front as directed by the usher. You will need to maintain 6ft. distancing as you proceed to and from Communion.

- Use hand sanitizer before communion
- Wear Mask as you come up for communion
- Exit your pew as directed by usher
- Maintain social distancing
- Receive Communion in the hand
- Step aside
 - take mask down
 - avoid touching the face covering
 - consume host
 - replace mask on face
 - proceed to your pew
 - return by going around to the opposite side

Do not backtrack or return on the same side you exited the pew to go to communion

Example: exit side = | pew | = return side

- **maintain social distancing**
- **return to your seats**

LEAVING MASS Guide

The side door and the chapel doors will be opened at the end of Mass so that all can leave through these doors.

No paper bulletins will be distributed

**Right half of church (facing altar):
EXIT through the side door**

**Left half of church (facing altar):
EXIT through the chapel doors**

- **Maintain social distancing**
- **Continue to Wear Mask**
- **Go straight to cars**
 - **No congregating or socializing**

**Presider/Concelebrant/Deacon will not be greeting you after Mass;
Unfortunately, there will be NO Extended Liturgy (donuts and coffee).**
