

## **Effective**

**May 18, 2021**

### **Masks**

**Anyone who is fully vaccinated\* is no longer required to wear masks on Diocesan properties. The verification of vaccinations will be based solely on the honor system.**

\*The CDC has provided that: *"In general, people are considered fully vaccinated:*

- *2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines*
- *2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine."*

**Out of consideration for the many people who remain medically vulnerable (including certain clergy and the elderly), the Diocesan Restoration Advisory Council encourages the continued wearing of masks. The wearing or not wearing a mask, is a personal decision that we all respect.**

**The Diocese is also encouraging the continuance of social distancing of **three (3) feet** between congregants that are not of the same household.**

### **Auxiliary Bishop Ordination**

**Priests, Deacons, Staff, and Friends of the Diocese of Las Vegas,**

**It is with great joy that I share with you the news that today, our Holy Father Pope Francis has appointed Monsignor Gregory W. Gordon, Vicar General of the Diocese of Las Vegas, as Auxiliary Bishop of Las Vegas with the Titular See of Novapetra.**

**This is the first time the Diocese of Las Vegas has ever had an Auxiliary Bishop. Archbishop Christophe Pierre, Apostolic Nuncio, hopes to attend the Ordination to proclaim the papal letter at the Ordination Mass of Bishop-elect Gordon on Friday, 16 July 2021. I will be the ordaining prelate of the Mass.**

**I ask you to keep Bishop-elect Gordon in your prayers. Kindly mark your calendars to concelebrate and to assist at the Episcopal Ordination Mass on July 16. The location of the Ordination is yet to be determined. More information regarding the details of that day will be forthcoming.**

**Let us give thanks to God for the blessings He has bestowed upon us, the clergy, and the faithful of the Diocese of Las Vegas on this day.**

### GOSPEL REFLECTION

*The Most Holy Trinity*

**Matthew 28: 16-20**

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

On Sunday, May 30th we celebrate the feast of the Most Holy Trinity, which reminds us of the mystery of one God in three Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is the communion of Divine Persons who are one with the others, one for the others, one in the others: this communion is the life of God, the mystery of the love of the Living God. Jesus revealed this mystery to us. He spoke to us of God as the Father; He spoke to us of the Spirit; and He spoke to us of Himself as the Son of God. Thus He revealed this mystery to us. After He rose, He sent the disciples to evangelize to the peoples, He told them to baptize them “in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit” (Mt 28:19). This command is entrusted by Christ in all ages to the Church, which has inherited the missionary mandate from the Apostles. He also directs it to each one of us who, through the power of Baptism, are part of his Community.

Therefore, today’s liturgical solemnity, while making us contemplate the amazing mystery from which we come and toward which we are going, renews for us the mission of living in communion with God and living in communion among ourselves on the model of the divine communion. We are called to live not as one without the others, above or against the others, but one with the others, for the others, and in the others. This means to accept and witness in harmony the beauty of the Gospel; experiencing love for one another and for all, sharing joy and suffering, learning to ask and grant forgiveness, appreciating various charisms under the guidance of Pastors. In a word, we have been entrusted with the task of edifying ecclesial communities which increasingly become families, capable of reflecting the splendor of the Trinity and evangelizing not only with the words but with the power of the love of God that lives within us.

### **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

*The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*

**Mark 14: 12-16, 22-26**

This Gospel on June 6th tells us that the disciples prepared for the meal after they “set out and went to the city” (v. 16). The Lord calls us also today to prepare for his coming not by keeping our distance but by entering our cities. That includes this city, whose very name – Ostia – means entrance, doorway. Lord, how many doors do you want us to open for you here? How many gates do you call us to unbar, how many walls must we tear down? Jesus wants the walls of indifference and silent collusion to be breached, iron bars of oppression and arrogance torn asunder, and paths cleared for justice, civility and legality. The vast beachfront of this city speaks to us of how beautiful it is to open our hearts and to set out in new directions in life. But this requires loosening the knots that keep us bound to the moorings of fear and depression. The Eucharist invites to let ourselves be carried along by the wave of Jesus, to not remain grounded on the beach in the hope that something may come along, but to cast into the deep, free, courageous and united.

The Gospel ends by telling us that the disciples, “after singing a hymn, went out” (v. 26). At the end of Mass, we too will go out; we will go forth with Jesus, who will pass through the streets of this city. Jesus wants to dwell among you. He wants to be part of your lives, to enter your houses and to offer his liberating mercy, his blessing and his consolation. You have experienced painful situations; the Lord wants to be close to you. Let us open our doors to him and say:

Come, Lord, and visit us.

We welcome you into our hearts,  
our families and our city.

We thank you because you have prepared for us  
the food of life and a place in your Kingdom.

Make us active in preparing your way,  
joyous in bringing you, who are life, to others,  
and thus to bring fraternity, justice and peace  
to our streets.

Amen.


