**How to sign up for Mass**

We will be using our e-giving site <https://kentnewmancenterparish.weshareonline.org> to manage sign ups.

You do not need to register or sign up for e-giving, although you must enter your email and phone number.

On the homepage, scroll down to Events and Collections and select the Mass you wish to attend.

The Masses are set up as ticketed events. There is no cost and you do not need to print a ticket. This is just the way the website is set up.

**Only register as a family.** You do not need to register each person in your party. We are basing our occupancy on families not individuals.

Carmen and Veronica will be monitoring the signups. Should we pass 30 sign ups, families beyond the allotted amount will be contacted and asked to remain at home.

Once you have registered on the site, you will have to **log in** the next time you want to sign up for Mass.

**Registrations will close at 5 pm on Saturday evening.** This will allow a staff member to contact any family beyond the 30 prior to Sunday morning. Should you not be allowed to register this weekend, please email the office to let us know. If families are getting shut out, we will try to figure out how to spread the opportunity to attend Mass around so that, if not weekly, everyone gets the chance to attend Mass at least every couple of weeks.
