INFORMATION ABOUT AND APPLICATION FOR DRIVING SAFETY COURSE

The law requires the Court to advise persons charged with certain misdemeanors under Subtitle C, Title 7, Transportation Code and committed while operating a motor vehicle of their right to successfully complete a driving safety course or motorcycle operator training course. To be eligible to apply for the course, you must not have completed an approved driving safety course or motorcycle operator training course within the 12 months preceding the date of the offense and must fully comply with the terms of the application below. The course is not available for dismissal of violations of law relating to insurance, driver's license, license plates, speeding 25 m.p.h. or more over the posted limit, speeding 95 m.p.h. or more, passing a school bus, reckless driving, fleeing a peace office, failure to stop and give information, failure to stop and render aid, violations occurring in a construction zone when workers were present or other serious traffic violations. You are also not eligible if you are now or were at the time you were cited the holder of a commercial driver's license. You may qualify for a driving course by mailing the application and affidavit found below fully completed to the Stagecoach Municipal Court, 16930 Boot Hill Rd., Stagecoach, TX 77355 by mail and postmarked on or before the court date on your ticket OR by applying in person at the Court. Your application and affidavit must be accompanied by payment in the amount of \$129.00. Upon receipt of a completed application, verification of license and insurance information and payment the appropriate fee and costs, you will be sent further instructions by the Court. DO NOT TAKE THE COURSE UNTIL YOU ARE AUTHORIZED TO DO SO BY THE COURT. The court costs and fee are not refundable. In addition to the court costs that are due with this application, you will also be responsible to pay the fees charged by the driving school and pay for the cost of your driving record as well. Information regarding how to obtain a driving record will be returned to you by the Court. Only driving safety programs approved by the Texas Education Agency will be accepted by the Court. If you complete the driving safety course within the time required and return the certificate together with a copy of your driving record to the Court, the charge against you will be dismissed and the Court will report to the Department of Public Safety the completion date of the driving safety course for inclusion in your driving record. If you should fail to present proof of completion of the driving safety course together with a copy of your driving record within the time prescribed, the Court will summon you to appear and show cause why a final judgment should not be entered and a conviction reported to the Department of Public Safety. To request a driving safety course, please complete the application and Affidavit found below.
