AN ORDINANCE by the Town Council of the Town of Stagecoach, Texas, adopting and accepting for and on behalf of the Town of Stagecoach, Montgomery County, Texas, the provisions of Title 28, Texas Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Town of Stagecoach has been duly incorporated in accordance with, and under the provisions of, Chapter 11, Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, a certified copy of the order declaring its incorporation being filed of record in the Deed Records of Montgomery County, Texas, in Volume 846, beginning at page 453; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to authority conferred by Article 961, V.A.T.C.S., a city, town or village incorporated under said Chapter 11 which satisfied one of the requirements prescribed therein may enlarge and expand its rights, immunities, powers, privileges, franchises, duties and responsibilities by accepting the provisions of Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, relating to cities and towns by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Council at a regular meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Stagecoach hereby finds and determines that one or more manufacturing establishments are located within the corporate limits of the Town, some of such manufacturing establishments being as follows:

1. A computer security systems manufacturing establishment owned and operated by Warren Wright;
2. Jo Ayers Ceramics;
3. A doll manufacturing establishment owned and operated by Nancy Parker; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council further deems it advisable for the Town of Stagecoach to accept and adopt the provisions of Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAGECOACH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That all of the findings and recitals contained in the preamble hereof are hereby adopted, incorporated by reference, and made a part hereof as if the same were set forth at length in this Section.


SECTION 2: That the Town of Stagecoach, Texas, hereby adopts and accepts as its organic law the provisions of Title 28, Texas Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns, including, without limitation, Chapter 1 through 10 thereof.

SECTION 3: That said Town shall hereafter be subject to all provisions of said Title 28, Texas Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, and amendments thereto, relating to cities and towns incorporated under the General Laws, and shall be vested with all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities and franchises therein conferred.

SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall be entered upon the official minutes of the Town Council of the Town of Stagecoach, Texas, and a copy thereof, signed by the Mayor and attested by the City Secretary, under the corporate seal of the Town, shall be filed and recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Montgomery County, Texas.

SECTION 5: That the public importance of this measure and the fact that it is to the best interest of the inhabitants of this municipal corporation to adopt and accept the provisions of said Title 28, Texas Revised Civil Statutes of 1925, and amendments thereto, at the earliest possible date constitute and create an urgent public necessity, requiring that any rule providing for ordinances to be read more than one time or at more than one meeting be suspended, and requiring that this ordinance be passed and take effect as an emergency measure, and such rule and provision is accordingly suspended and this ordinance is passed as an emergency measure, and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so ordained.
