ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN OF STAGECOACH, TEXAS,
CHANGING THE DESIGNATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY
FROM "TOWN" TO "CITY"; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE
DATE; AND PROVIDING FOR RECORDING OF THIS
ORDINANCE WITH THE COUNTY CLERK OF MONTGOMERY
COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Stagecoach is a Type A General-Law municipality, as that term is used and defined by Section 5.001 of the Texas Local Government Code, the Town having operated, immediately preceding September 1, 1987, under Chapters 1-10, Title 28, Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance adopting and accepting Chapters 1-10, Title 28, of the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, passed by the Town Council on December 17, 1984, did not specifically change the designation of the Town of Stagecoach to "City of Stagecoach"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Stagecoach has been informally referred to as the "City of Stagecoach" since the date of the said Ordinance adopting Chapters 1-10, Title 28, of the Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council deems it advisable to formally change the designation of the municipality from "Town" to "City", as permitted by Section 5.902 of the Texas Local Government Code; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAGECOACH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the designation of the Town of Stagecoach as a "town" be and the same is hereby changed to "city", and from and after the date of passage of this Ordinance, Stagecoach shall be known as the "City of Stagecoach." The change in designation shall not affect the municipality's corporate existence or powers.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be entered upon the official Minutes of the City Council of the City of Stagecoach, Texas, and a copy thereof, signed by the Mayor and attested by the

City Secretary, under the corporate seal of the Town of Stagecoach, shall be filed and recorded in the office of the County Clerk of Montgomery County, Texas.

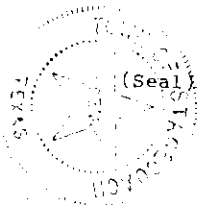
SECTION 3: That the public importance of this measure and the fact that it is in the best interest of the inhabitants of this municipal corporation constitutes and creates an urgent public necessity requiring that any rule providing for ordinances to be read more than one time or at more than one meeting be suspended, and requires that this Ordinance be passed and take effect as an emergency measure, and such rule and provision is accordingly suspended and this Ordinance is passed as an emergency measure, and shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage, and IT IS SO ORDAINED.
