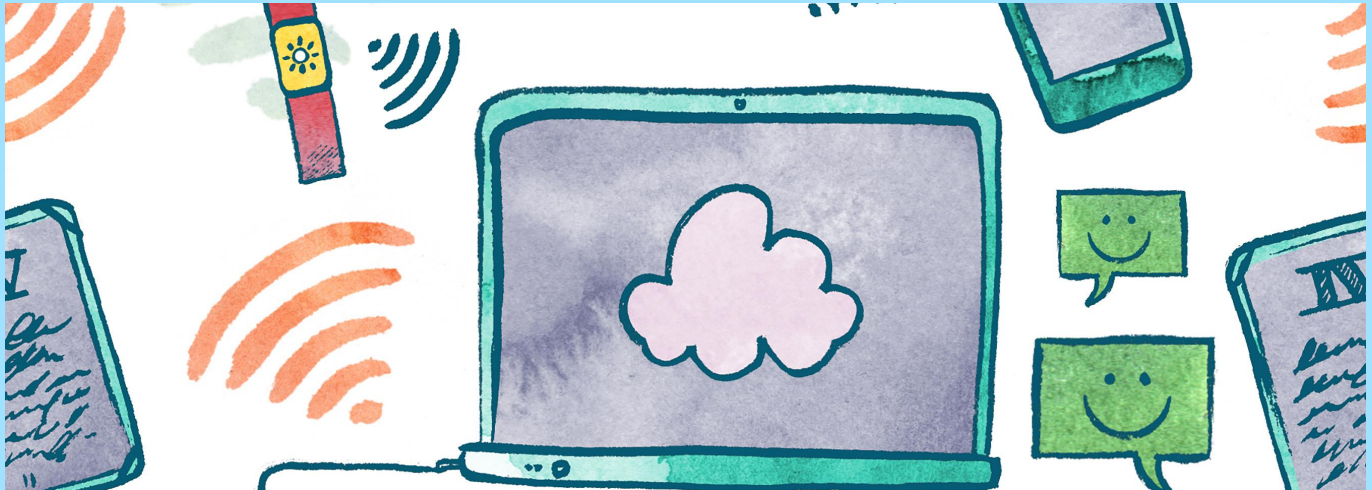


St. Anthony of Padua Catholic School REMOTE LEARNERS NEWSLETTER

Your weekly update for our remote learners.



DRESS

Students are not required to be in uniform when attending live-streamed courses through Google Meet. However, all remote students are expected to be dressed in alignment with the guidelines in the Family Handbook for Free Dress Days.

Students should not attend class in pajamas.

GETTING MATERIALS

Parents will be asked to pick up materials for quarter one on Monday afternoon (August 10th) between 1pm - 4pm or Tuesday morning (August 11th) between 10 am - noon.

Textbooks and some supplies will be given at this time in addition to middle school chromebooks. Families will be able to pick up at front desk.

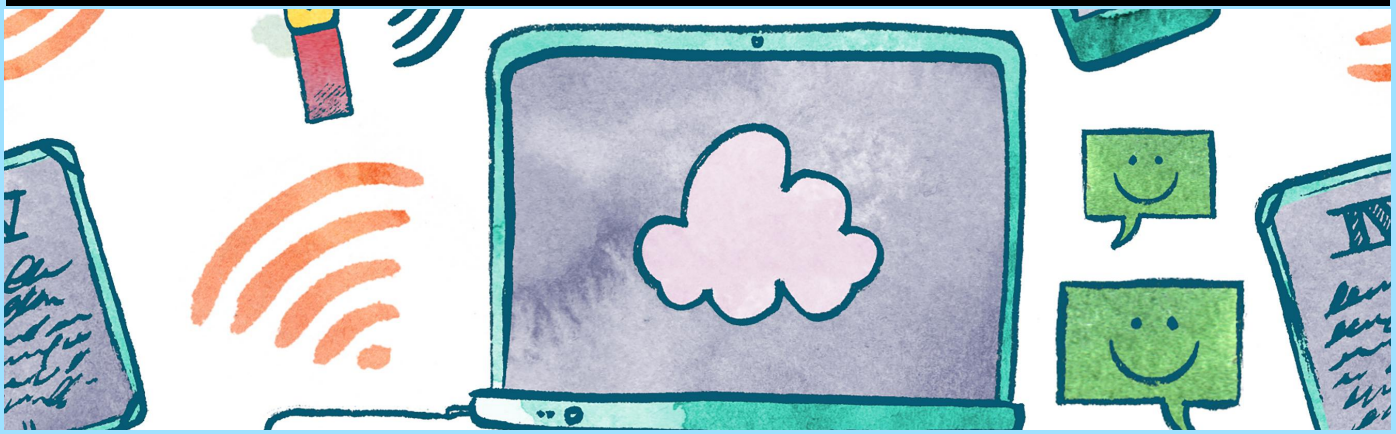
SUBMISSION OF ASSIGNMENTS & TESTS

Students are encouraged to submit assignments through Google Classroom. All work and assessments should be completed by the student independently unless otherwise noted. Parents will also have the ability to bring assignments to the school campus.

Assignment submission and rubrics are the same expectations for on-campus and remote learners. Last assignments will incur the same penalties as on-campus students.

TECHNOLOGY NEEDS

All students will need a device which is able to access Google Classroom and Google Meet. A camera is strongly encouraged especially for students attending synchronous classes. This will more easily foster participation. Students may also need the ability to scan and print. The goal of the teacher is to limit the need to print materials but at times, this may be necessary.



LIVE CLASSES

Students will have the option to attend synchronous classes via Google Meet for core classes. Classes will not be live-streamed all day. Your student's teacher(s) will share their schedule.

Students also have the option to go back and review classes. Links will be posted in Google Classroom.

When using Google Meet, students must use their actual name as their identity.

Students should be actively engaged with the live classroom and parents should ensure the elimination of other distractions such as electronics (TV, phones), younger siblings, etc. Students should be visible on the screen.

Students learning from home will refrain from messaging to other students in class during the schedules school day unless otherwise instructed by the teacher to participate in group discussions.

Auxiliary classes may not always be able to be live-streamed. Remote students will not be penalized for Auxiliary classes.

MASS

All students are encouraged to join the students on campus in attending the Wednesday 9am live-streamed Mass each week via the church website: <https://ap.church/mass-live-stream/>.

ATTENDANCE

Students or parents should send the homeroom /advisory teacher a daily e-mail which serves as the attendance record to be reported in FACTS and documented on the report card.

Parents with student enrolled in the remote learning program should refrain from taking vacations during school allotted times which would hinder student participation and progress.

Students in remote learning program will follow school guidelines regarding sick days and the process of making up school work in a timely manner.

SECOND QUARTER

Families will have the opportunity to select their second quarter learning preference. This survey will go out by September 11th and will be due on September 25th.
