## EASTER SUNDAY PARKING

Well, Easter is almost here and we want to see if we can improve on the parking procedures. So here are some important facts that will aid the Parking Enforcement Officers to get you parked quickly, keep all of you safe (whether on foot or in a car), and keep traffic flowing on Clayton road and through the parking lot:

1. Enter the Church parking lot on Clayton Road. (**The back gate is exit only**). Do not attempt to enter through the back gate - you will be turned away and slow the parking process down.
2. The parking plan will be to fill from the back lot to the front. This allows the officers a clear line of sight to ensure that they know where all the empty spaces are, keeps traffic moving, gets you to a parking spot more quickly, improves safety, and clears **Clayton Road** the quickest.
3. Please follow the instructions of the officers. Believe me, it will save time and get you parked the fastest. The officers will maintain control of the traffic flow. So, look for their direction. They know where the parking is.
4. Please do not run over traffic control devices. They may not damage your bumper, but they will damage the undercarriage and sensors under the newer cars. On the lower cars they get caught and begin to burn/melt against the exhaust, and smell. Many times, you will need to jack up the car to free them.
5. The officers will keep extra places for handicap vehicles open near the Church (these are limited). They will try to park you as close as possible to the church. If you do not have handicap plates, please have the plaque visible, so the officer can direct you.
6. If you need to just drop someone off, let them know. After dropping off, get back into the flow of cars to get parked. The officers will be looking for those who try to abuse this service.
7. **Parking at the Rectory parking lot will be for musicians and choir only.**
8. Please lower the window and turn down the radio, so you can hear the instructions from the officers.

#### DIOS NO CONDENA: DIOS PERDONA

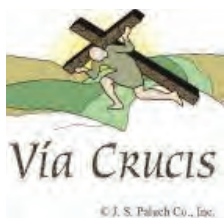
La Cuaresma es el camino que nos conduce hacia la fuente de vida. Jesús entregará su vida en la cruz, y pagará por nuestras faltas, para la salvación de todos nuestros pecados. Jesús posee un corazón vibrante de amor, perdón y misericordia. El deseo más grande de Dios es perdonar. Pensamos algunas veces que Dios castiga, y que no perdonará nuestras faltas, pero Dios nos ama tanto que nos da en abundancia todos los días: el don de la vida, los alimentos, el trabajo, la familia, y los amigos. Todo es don gratuito del plan divino de Dios. Sin embargo, cuando no hacemos buenas decisiones; sabemos que habrá consecuencias, quizás tuvimos la opción de elegir bien, pero nos dejamos seducir por lo más fácil y rápido. Elegimos sin encomendarnos a Dios. Y terminamos culpando a Dios y enojándonos porque Él no viene a nuestro auxilio.

Cuando el hombre se arrepiente y regresa a Dios encuentra que Él siempre permaneció cerca, que Dios nunca se alejó, ni lo abandono, ni lo castigo. Al contrario, Dios fue quien lo protegió, fortaleció y guio para descubrir el camino del amor y de la paz. En el Evangelio de San Juan los escribas y fariseos sorprendieron a una mujer en adulterio y según la ley había que apedrearla. Ellos le preguntan a Jesús **¿y tú que dices?** Querían saber si la iba a condenar o incumplir la ley. Jesús que conoce el corazón de los fariseos y escribas, les dijo: **“el que no tenga pecado que tire la primera**

**pedra”**. Todos se fueron, solo quedo Jesús y la mujer. Fácilmente, condenamos a la otra persona y la acusamos de sus pecados. Debemos ser humildes, arrepentirnos de nuestros pecados y ayudar a otros a arrepentirse.

Jesús nos devuelve la identidad de hijos e hijas de Dios en el maravilloso Sacramento de la Confesión. **Jesús le pregunta: “¿dónde están los que te acusaban? ¿Nadie te ha condenado?” Ella le contestó: “Nadie, Señor”. Y Jesús le dijo: “Tampoco yo te condeno. Vete y ya no vuelvas a pecar”**. La misericordia de Dios es infinita, su perdón es amor. El pecado nos quita la belleza de ver a Dios en su totalidad. El pecado destruye nuestra relación con Dios. El pecado nos hace sentir sucios, e inmerecedores del perdón de Dios. El pecado nos quita el privilegio de vivir nuestra vida feliz, alegre, en paz y amor. A través de Jesús descubrimos el amor misericordioso de Dios Padre. Nos quita la venda de nuestros ojos y llena nuestro corazón de amor. En la confesión Dios restaura nuestros corazones rotos y lastimados por el odio, la venganza, el rencor, la envidia, el orgullo, que anidan en él. Hoy es nuestra oportunidad de despertar de nuestra vida pecaminosa y derrotar al enemigo que nos mantiene sumisos y esclavos de sus trampas. Dios quiere abrazarnos, Él quiere decirnos que nadie tiene que condenarnos y tampoco Él nos condenará. Solo desea ver nuestro arrepentimiento y nuestro corazón contrito y humillado para exaltarnos en el amor, la alegría y la paz.
