THOUGHTS FROM FR. OSCAR ROJAS



The Solemnity Of The Most Holy Trinity

The presence of the Holy Trinity is the core of our faith and Christian life. Since the day we received the sacrament of Baptism we have been signed on the forehead with the Holy Trinity: in the name of the Father,

and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. God has revealed his unity with the Son and the Holy Spirit to all of us as his children. At the beginning, God spoke to his people through prophets, but later on, he spoke through his Son Jesus Christ. His Son has revealed God as his Father. Jesus addressed God in prayer many times as Father. There is an intimate relationship between the Son and the Father. We have entered into an intimacy with God through the manifestation of his Son in our life. It was not possible for human beings to restore the relationship with God. But God so desired to be close to his children that he sent his only begotten Son to save us from sin. Once Jesus' mission ended, he ascended to his Father and promised to send the Holy Spirit to energize the hearts of his disciples to continue spreading his message of love. The Holy Spirit and the Son embrace human beings to bring them to our eternal Father. The Most Holy Trinity represents the perfect model of the human family. His intimate life is the desire of true human love. God wants us to build one family in union with him.

Every person has been created in the likeness of the Trinity and lives in communion with those around us and God. In the Second reading, Saint Paul said *“because the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.”* There is no doubt of the gift of love given to us because we all have been baptized and anointed with the holy oil of chrism on our head. Indeed, it means we have received the gift of love through the Holy Spirit. God is love; God lives in us. God has come to live and unite us as one family. The gifts of love and unity should replace meaningless, ineffective and empty words. But love and unity do not always live in hearts. To our horror, we often hear of mass shootings of innocent people around the world. This is an example of the loss of love and the poison of evil in the human heart. Also, we see division within families and broken relationships due to anger, hatred, envy, pride, and self-sufficiency. This is because of evil in our hearts. It should not happen. We belong to God. God so loves us that he sent his Son to bring us closer to Him, and even more through the Holy Spirit who is in our heart, the most precious gift of love. Every human being and family should be united and nourish each other's life with the fragrance and power of love.

Today is our opportunity to continue embracing the gift of love that God has poured out through the Holy Spirit within our hearts. It is time to remove the poison of evil within our hearts and destroy any division among families. Let us follow the perfect model of the most Holy Trinity: Unity.
