

## THOUGHTS FROM FR. MATHEW VELLANKAL



Today's readings invite us to believe in a loving, patient, merciful, forgiving God. The good news Jesus preached was that God is not a cruel, judging and punishing God. He is always in search of His lost and straying children, as Jesus explains in the three parables of today's Gospel.

Today's Gospel reading is from chapter 15 of Luke's Gospel and it has been called "the Gospel within the Gospel," because it is the distilled essence of the good news about the mercy of our forgiving heavenly father. The whole chapter is essentially one distinct parable, the "parable of the lost and found," with three illustrations: the story of the lost sheep, the story of the lost coin and the story of the lost son. Someone flippantly called this chapter the "the lost and found" department of the Bible because everything that is lost is found. These parables remind us that we have a God who welcomes sinners and forgives their sins whenever they return to Him with genuine contrition and resolution.

We need to live every day as our merciful God's forgiven children. Let us begin every day offering all our actions for God's glory and praying for the strengthening anointing of the Holy Spirit, so that we may obey God's holy will by

doing good and avoiding evil, and try to live in God's presence everywhere. Before we go to bed at night, let us examine our conscience and confess to God our sins and failures of the day, asking His pardon and forgiveness. Let us resolve to receive the sacrament of reconciliation if we have fallen into serious sins. Let us continue to ask for God's forgiveness before we receive Jesus in holy communion during the Holy Mass. Thus, let us live a peaceful life as forgiven prodigal children, getting daily reconciled with God, our merciful and forgiving father.

Let us ask God for the courage and good will to extend His forgiveness to others. Let us realize the truth that our brothers and sisters deserve and expect from us the same compassion, kindness, and forgiveness which we receive from our merciful God. As forgiven prodigals, we must become forgiving people, for Jesus taught us to pray, "forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." As we continue with the celebration of the Holy Mass, let us pray also for God's divine mercy on all of us who have fallen away from God's grace. Let us open our eyes to see, and ears to hear, that Jesus is welcoming us back home!

What does a Home Meal Delivery Driver do? Once a month, on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday you pick up from the Concord Senior Center at Baldwin Park and deliver 12-16 meals to homebound seniors in East Concord and Clayton. Meals are packaged in thermal containers and stay hot for up to 2 hours for delivery between 10:00AM and 12:00PM. Along with meals, drivers deliver smiles and a lifeline connection. You check in with your clients and make sure they're healthy and safe. Detailed driving directions are included along with each meal. You'll use your own car and must carry personal liability insurance and have use of a cell phone. Orientation and Training is provided by the Meals on Wheels Walnut Creek office. Are you an adult who is interested in receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation? St. Bonaventure invites you to participate in our Adult Confirmation Program, if you:



**PENSAMIENTOS DEL PADRE MATHEW VELLANKAL**



Las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a creer en un Dios amoroso, paciente, misericordioso y perdonador. La buena noticia que Jesús predicó fue que Dios no es un Dios cruel, que juzga y castiga. Él siempre está en busca de sus hijos perdidos y extraviados, como Jesús explica en las tres parábolas del Evangelio de hoy. La lectura del Evangelio de hoy es del capítulo 15 del Evangelio de Lucas y se ha llamado "el Evangelio dentro del Evangelio", porque es la esencia destilada de las buenas nuevas sobre la misericordia de nuestro perdonador padre celestial. Todo el capítulo es esencialmente una parábola distinta, la "parábola de los perdidos y encontrados", con tres ilustraciones: la historia de la oveja perdida, la historia de la moneda perdida y la historia del hijo perdido. Alguien llamó a este capítulo con ligereza el departamento de la Biblia "los perdidos y encontrados" porque todo lo que se pierde se encuentra. Estas parábolas nos recuerdan que tenemos un Dios que da la bienvenida a los pecadores y perdona sus pecados cada vez que regresan a Él con verdadera contrición y resolución.

Necesitamos vivir todos los días como hijos misericordiosos de Dios. Comencemos todos los días ofreciendo todas nuestras acciones para la gloria de Dios y orando por el fortaleci-

miento de la unción del Espíritu Santo para que podamos obedecer la santa voluntad de Dios haciendo el bien y evitando el mal, y tratar de vivir en la presencia de Dios en todas partes. Antes de acostarnos por la noche, examinemos nuestra conciencia y confesemos a Dios nuestros pecados y fracasos del día, pidiéndole perdón y olvido. Resolvamos recibir el Sacramento de la Reconciliación si hemos caído en pecados graves. Sigamos pidiendo el perdón de Dios antes de recibir a Jesús en la Santa Comunión durante la Santa Misa. Por lo tanto, vivamos una vida pacífica como hijos pródigos perdonados, reconciliándonos diariamente con Dios, nuestro padre misericordioso y perdonador.


