

Reopening Plan for Indoor Worship St. Bonaventure Catholic Community

(Subject to change based on state and county regulations: Currently in Orange Tier)

All indoor liturgies will take place in the main church.

The chapel will remain open daily for private prayer and devotion with a capacity of 15 people.

DAILY MASS IN THE CHURCH

Daily Mass in English takes place Monday thru Friday at 9:00am and on Saturday at 8:00am.

Daily Mass in Spanish takes place Tuesdays and Thursdays at 7:00pm.

- 1. Check your Condition.** If you have any COVID-19 symptoms or feel sick in any way (coughing, sneezing, runny nose, or fever), are at a higher risk of illness, or afraid of becoming sick, please stay home.
- 2. Obligation:** The obligation to attend Sunday Mass and receive Holy Communion is still dispensed for all Catholics in the Diocese of Oakland.
- 3. Face Masks:** Those over age 3 must wear a face covering that covers the nose and mouth. Please bring your own.
- 4. Entering:** Only the center doors of the church will be used for entering.
- 5. Social Distancing:** Every other pew is roped off. While seated, standing, and walking, those who are not in the same household must maintain social distancing and remain six feet apart from each other.
- 6. Worship Aids:** If you like to follow along with the prayers at Mass, bring your own worship aids such as the Magnificat booklet. There will not be missalettes or hymnals available.
- 7. The Lord's Prayer:** Hands should not be held during the Lord's Prayer (Our Father). There is no posture of the hands prescribed for this prayer during Mass.
- 8. Sign of Peace:** A simple bow or wave without any physical interaction is appropriate during the Sign of Peace.
- 9. Holy Communion:** The reception of Holy Communion will take place during the usual time of the Mass.
- 10. Exiting:** We ask that all exit through the side exits (glass doors) of the church.

HOLY COMMUNION OUTSIDE OF MASS

Up until November 1, Holy Communion via walkup will be offered on Sundays between 12:00pm and 1:00pm on the church plaza. Beginning on November 1, Holy Communion via walkup will be offered in front of the Ministry Center between 12:00pm and 12:30pm.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation will continue to take place on Saturdays from 3:30-4:30 pm in Classrooms A3 and B4 in the Ministry Center. We ask that you maintain social distancing while waiting in line, using the lines on the floor of the walkway as a guide. Everyone must wear a face mask. Social distancing between the priest and penitent will be maintained. Hand sanitizer is provided in the classrooms.
