NUPTIAL LITURGICAL MUSIC SELECTIONS

1. PRELUDE

To set the tone for the celebration, the instrumentalist(s) will provide music beginning fifteen minutes before the Liturgy. Also, at this time, the cantor may sing any liturgical selection(s) you choose. The Mothers' Entrance is the final prelude selection (instrumental or sung).

Also notice that the hymns in our hymnal are grouped according to Season, Occasion, Rite, or Part of the Mass for which it is most appropriate.
