



Public Masses will resume at Christ the King effective for Sunday Mass the weekend of May 16th/17th and for weekday Masses beginning the week May 18th; and subject to the following guidelines:

- Sunday Mass schedule will be:
Saturday 8:00 a.m., Vigil 4:00 p.m. (English); 8:00 p.m. (Vietnamese).
Sunday 7:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. (English); 2:00 p.m. (Vietnamese); 5:00 p.m. (English); and 7:00 p.m. (Spanish). **NOTE: Beginning June 7, the 10:30 a.m. Sunday Mass will be removed and replaced with the normal 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses.**
- Weekday Mass will be at 8:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Mass will be at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday and Thursday. **Weekday Masses beginning in June will return to the Chapel.** There will be no Adoration until June 1, 2020. Details and guidelines will be provided at a later date.
- This schedule provides ample opportunity to clean the church between Masses.
- Sunday 10:30 a.m. Mass will be recorded in order to provide those unable to attend the opportunity to view the Mass.

Physical distancing and seating guidelines for each Mass are as follows:

- State and Local laws and restrictions that pertain to physical distancing will be adhered to. The requirement of physical distancing of 6 feet will impose restrictions on the capacity of the number of the faithful participating in Masses.
- Pews will be marked accordingly as to which pews are available as well as proper seating. Every other pew will be utilized with space marked by blue tape to ensure proper physical distancing and to guide the faithful to sit at least 6 feet from each other. However, members of a single household do not need to have physical distancing from each other.
- There are only a limited number of seats to accommodate those able to attend and it is therefore recommended that you arrive early to obtain a seat. The Faithful should practice social distancing and immediately enter the Sanctuary and be seated. When the seats are filled, we are not allowed to compromise guidelines by going over limited capacity. There will be no standing.

- All seating will be in the main church only and seating in Gathering Area, Sacristy and adjoining area is not allowed. Ushers will monitor seating and guidelines. Please comply with these guidelines.

ALL Faithful participating in and attending Mass are required to wear a mask or suitable face covering. This includes Altar Servers, Sacristans, Ushers, Eucharistic Ministers and Readers. It is the responsibility of all attendees that they bring with them a mask or suitable face covering. Wearing of masks or suitable face covering at all times other than at the moment of consuming Holy Communion is required.

Masks will not be provided. The Faithful are required to have and wear face masks or suitable face covering and there are no exceptions. Due to the cost and availability of cleaning wipes and hand sanitizers, those attending Mass will be expected to bring their own. Trash cans will be provided in the gathering area for disposal of items as you exit.

Entry and Exit doors will be the 2 main doors as well as Larkin Road door. Ushers will direct entrance into the church as well as exiting the church to ensure an orderly movement with appropriate physical separation. Ushers will be stationed at all open doors before and during Mass to monitor activity. Ushers will assist and direct movement up the communion aisle to ensure proper physical distancing between lines and individuals. The Faithful should exit immediately at the conclusion of Mass.

Before and following Mass, there will be cleaning and disinfecting of all spaces, pews and seating areas. The Mass schedule has been developed in order to allow enough time for proper and thorough cleaning and disinfecting.

Music ministry is limited to Music Director (Pianist) and cantor. Choir area will not be used nor will 2 pews by the organ. All worship aids, hymnals and supplements will be removed and not provided. This includes paper copies of music. Those attending Mass may bring their own missals/missalettes to follow.

There will be 1 Reader assigned with normal duties. Masks can be removed while reading. Please do not touch the microphone.

There will be a Sacristan who will perform their normal duties.

There will be 3 altar servers per Mass who will perform their normal duties.

During the Mass:

Offertory: collection baskets will not be passed in the pews or seating areas. Baskets will be placed at the Baptismal Font as well as Larkin Road door for the contributions of the faithful. Baskets will be monitored by Ushers. On line giving is greatly encouraged.

Procession of Gifts has been omitted.

Lord's Prayer: handholding is not permitted.

Sign of Peace has been omitted.

Holy Communion

Distribution of Holy Communion will only be the Host and is to be received in the hand. Gloves, if worn, must be removed to receive Holy Communion.

There will be 2 Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion assigned and their participation is affected by the number of clergy at the Mass. Those EMHCs assigned are to check to see how many clergy will be at the Mass.

Gift Shop
