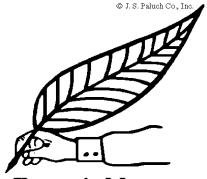

**HOPE AND LIFE**

Today's readings tell the story of two widows. The  
first reading relates the plight of the widow with whom the  
prophet Elijah stayed; the Gospel tells about the widow of  
Nain. In each story, the widow's only son had died. For  
people who lived in those cultures, the son was the only  
support of a widow, and the carrying on of the family  
name by the son was equal to immortality. A widow  
whose only son has died could lose all hope.

Elijah and Jesus are the restorers of hope; they bring  
the sons back to life. Saint Paul was metaphorically  
raised from the dead when he experienced the  
conversion and call from God that he describes in today's  
second reading.

What are Christians called to do today? We may not  
be able to raise the dead, but perhaps we can rekindle  
hope for a single parent. We may not be able to convert a  
persecutor like Paul, but if we speak the gospel openly  
and gently with our lives, we might touch a life with the  
Good News.

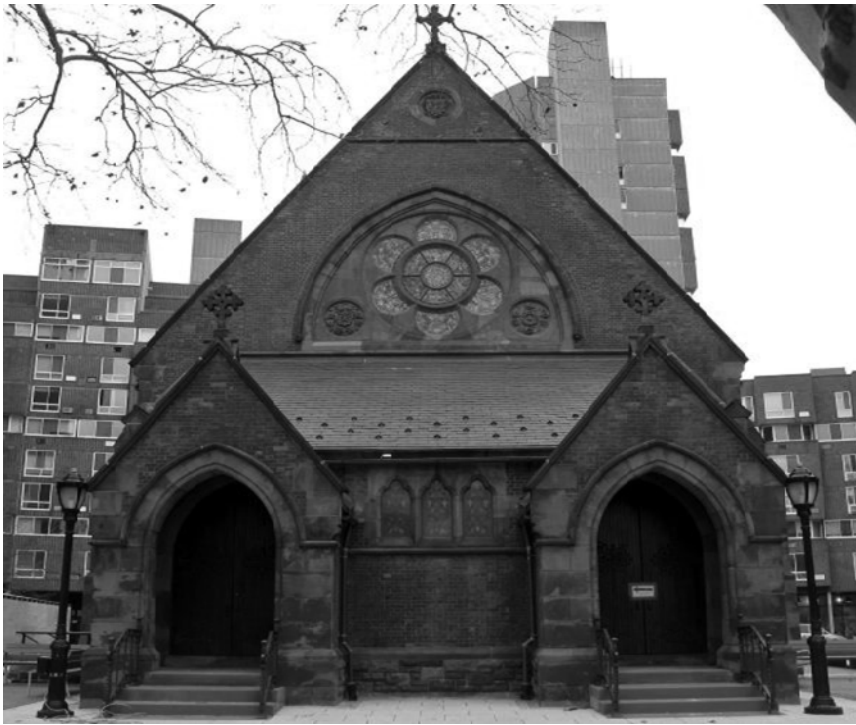

## Zomrela slovenská misionárka Veronika Terézia Racková SSpS

Slovenská misionárka sestra Veronika Terézia Racková SSpS, ktorá pôsobila ako lekárka v Južnom Sudáne, zomrela 20. mája 2016 v nemocnici v Keni. TK KBS to potvrdila provinciálna predstavená Misijnej kongregácie služobníc Ducha Svätého sr. Lucia Slušná. Sr. Veronika Terézia Racková pracovala ako vedúca zdravotného strediska sv. Bakhity v meste Yei v Južnom Sudáne. V pondelok 16. mája sa jej autom hodinu po polnoci stalo terčom streľby ozbrojencov. Vracala sa domov po odvoze pacienta do inej nemocnice. Pri útoku ju postrelili. Podľa lokálnych médií boli ako páchatelia činu zadržaní traja vojaci z armádnej jednotky tzv. „Joint Operation Unit“, rozmiestnenej v oblasti na zaistenie bezpečnosti civilistov počas noci. Absolvovala sériu operácií v miestnej nemocnici v Južnom Sudáne a v Keni. Sestra Veronika Terézia Racková zomrela vo veku 58 rokov. Narodila sa 8. januára 1958 v Bánove v okrese Nové Zámky. Študovala na gymnáziu v Šuranoch a lekársky titul získala na Karlovej univerzite v Prahe. Po roku lekárskej praxe začala rehoľnú formáciu v Ríme, v ktorej neskôr pokračovala v Nemecku. Rehoľné sľuby zložila v roku 1989. Sestra Veronika pôsobila okrem Slovenska v Taliansku, Holandsku, Nemecku, Rakúsku, Írsku, Anglicku, Indonézii a Ghane a napokon v Južnom Sudáne. Na Slovensku v minulosti vykonávala aj úrad provinciálnej predstavenej. Svätá omša za dušu zosnulej sr. Veroniky Theresie bola v kaplnke Kláštora Ducha Svätého v Ivanke pri Nitre dňa 28. mája 2016 o 11.00 hodine, a v kostole sv. Michala Archanjela v Bánove bude dňa 30. mája 2016 o 16.00 hodine. V Nairobi v Keni sa konala zádušná svätá omša v pondelok, 23. mája 2016. Odpočinutie večné daj jej, Pane, a svetlo večné nech jej svieti! Nech odpočíva v pokoji!
