ASH WEDNESDAY

This week is Ash Wednesday. At St. John's ashes will be distributed after the 8 A.M. Penitential Service, at 10 A.M. (no Mass), after 12:15 Mass, at 2 P.M. (no Mass) and after 6 P.M. Mass. At St. Frances Cabrini ashes will be distributed after the 9 A.M. and 7 P.M. Mass. Wednesday, March 1st, is the first day of Lent, the time of reflection, penitence and preparation leading to Easter Sunday. Clergy all over the world dispense ashes, making the sign of the cross on the bowed foreheads before them. Ashes are made by burning palm fronds blessed on previous year's Palm Sunday. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of strict fast and abstinence from meat for all Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive. All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat all Fridays in Lent. Lent is actually longer than 40 days. There are 46 days between Ash Wednesday and Easter, but Sundays are not part of Lent fast and abstinence.

ASHES FOR THE HOMEBOUND

If you know of someone who is physically unable to come to church on Ash Wednesday but wishes to receive ashes, please inform us. We will have small envelopes of blessed ashes and a leaflet containing a prayer available for the distribution of ashes to the homebound. Please contact the parish office.

If you have someone sick at home or in a nursing home and wish we would visit them, please let us know at the Rectory.

POPOLCOVÁ STREDA

Tento týždeň v stredu je Popolcová streda. Popolec budeme udeľovať v našom kostole po bohoslužbách o ôsmej ráno, o 10:00 dopoludnia (nie je omša), po sv. omši o 12:15, o 2:00 popoludní (nie je omša) a po sv. omši o šiestej večer. V stredu 1. marca začína veľký pôst a 40-denná príprava na oslavu Veľkej noci. Na začiatku pôstneho obdobia, na Popolcovú streda, sa značia čelá veriacich popolom. Popol je už svojím pôvodom prirodzeným znamením pomínutelnosti, je to aj symbol ľútosti a pokánia. Popol na Popolcovú streda sa získava pálením palmových listov, ktoré boli posvätené predošlý rok na Kvetnú nedeľu. Popolcová streda a Veľký piatok sú dni prísneho pôstu. To znamená jedenkrát sa dosýta najesť a dvakrát si zajesť. Tieto pravidlá platia pre všetkých katolíkov vo veku od 18 do 59 rokov. Katolíci starší než 14 rokov sa v piatky v pôste majú zdržiavať mäsa. Pôstne obdobie je dlhšie než 40 dní, od Popolcovej stredy do Veľkej noci je 46 dní, ale nedele nepatria do Pôstu a zdržiavania sa jedá.
