For those of us who love to pray the rosary, we know that August 22 is the day when we celebrate the Queenship of Mary. This Marian Feast Day always takes place a week after the Assumption of our Blessed Mother into heaven. As we celebrate Mary's crowning, we call to mind that the Lord our God gives her the crown of righteousness; the crown fit for a queen, the loyal obedient servant of the Father and dedicated Mother of the Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. 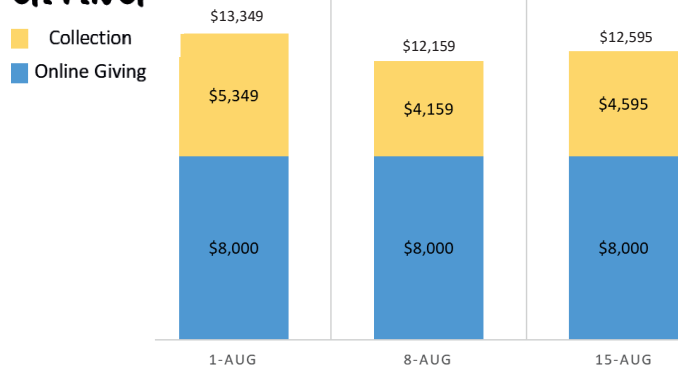
