

Sr. Vincent Carlino C.S.JB. – 95 years old
Sister of Saint John the Baptist for 75 years

Sr. Vincent Carlino, C.S.JB. passed away peacefully to her eternal reward at Providence Rest Nursing Home in the Bronx, on Sunday, November 8, 2015. The Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated for her on Friday, November 13, 2015 at Providence Rest Chapel, Bronx, New York. Sister was interred at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Valhalla, NY.

Sister Vincent, born Anna Carlino on September 16, 1920 in Baucina, Palermo, Sicily to Vincenzo and Maria Santa. She entered the Sisters of St. John the Baptist in 1939 in Rome, Italy. She made her first Profession of Vows in 1941 and made her Final Profession on September 8, 1946 in Rome, Italy.

After various assignments in Italy, Sister was missioned to the newly opened All Souls Convent in Hamilton, Canada in 1962. Sister served as cook to the community and to the children of All Souls daycare. In 1969, Sister Vincent was assigned to Immaculate Heart Novitiate located in Glen Cove, NY and served as a cook to the postulants and novices. From 1979-2014, she resided at Providence Rest Convent, as a sacristan.

During her lifetime she had many opportunities to make pilgrimages to the shrines of Fatima, Lourdes and the Holy Land.

Sister Vincent was an excellent cook who delighted in serving the community with her gift. She was a dedicated religious who faithfully fulfilled her ministerial and communal responsibilities.

Sister is survived by many nieces and nephews both in the United States and Montreal, Canada.
