Sister of Saint John the Baptist for 73years

Sr. Lucy Muni, C.S.JB. passed to her eternal reward at Providence Rest Nursing Home in the Bronx, on Saturday, June 22, 2013. The Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated for her on Tuesday, June 25th at Providence Rest Chapel, Bronx, New York. Sister was interred at Gate of Heaven Cemetery, Westchester, NY.

Sister Lucy began teach for the community 1940 until 1974 teaching young people. She taught High School Mathematics at St. John Villa High School, Staten Island, from 1940 -1952. Mt. St. John Academy, Gladstone, NJ, and was even Principal for two years there. She taught at Bishop Burke High School, Gloversville, NY and was the dean at Alphonsus College, Woodcliffe Lake, NJ and also Moore Catholic High School on Staten Island, from 1974-1979.

Having a keen eye for numbers, she was appointed Provincial Treasurer for the American Province January 1979 to July 1987. During those years, she even taught classes at Archbishop Stepinac High School in White Plains.

In December of 1990, she was assigned to Providence Rest Nursing Home, Bronx, NY as the Director of Purchasing until 1999.

In July 2007, Sister retired to the Mt. St. John Convent, Purchase, NY. Needed great physical care, Sister returned to Providence Rest Nursing Home as a resident in March 2009 until her death on June 22, 2013.

Sister Lucy was a dedicated religious who faithfully fulfilled her ministerial and communal responsibilities and brought joy to all she knew – her family, sisters in community, friends and students.

She will be remembered by her many students she taught in High School as one who encouraged excellence.

Sister is survived by several nieces; who live in various states of this country.
