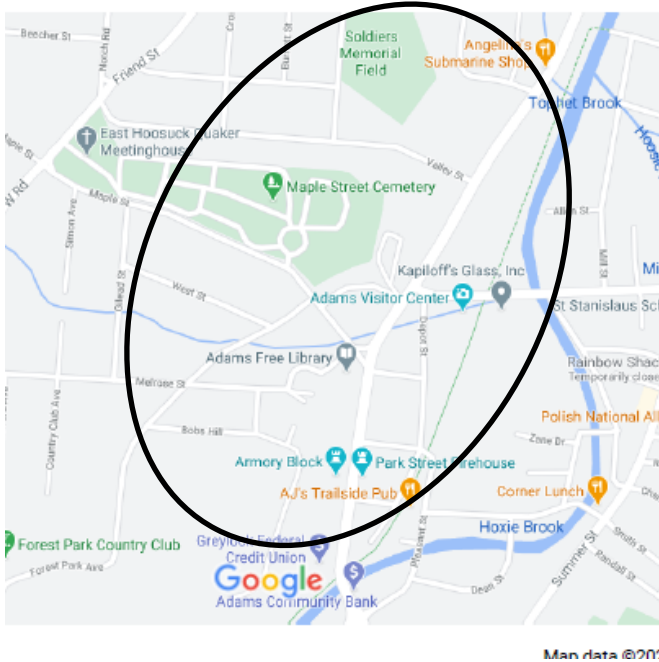


New Mass Opportunity at St. John Paul II Parish

Beginning with the Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, our parish will be using an FM transmitter to broadcast the Masses. This will give parishioners the opportunity to sit in their vehicle in the parking lot or streets surrounding the church and listen to the Mass. There will be an opportunity to receive communion outside the church immediately after Mass. To hear the Mass, you will tune your car radio to FM 91.7. You may need to turn the volume up higher a bit. The maps below show where you can park to hear the Mass on your radio. To receive communion at the end of Mass, you will drive your vehicle to the spot designated for Communion at each church and remain in your vehicle with your mask on. You will be able to receive Communion by hand.

Once the Eucharistic Minister has moved away from your window, you may remove your mask to consume. Please follow the Communion flow described below. Please watch for people and other vehicles!

Notre Dame Outdoor Communion Flow
Please enter the Notre Dame Church parking lot from Maple St. Eucharistic Ministers will be positioned at the edge of the parking lot where the sidewalk to the ramp is located. Once you have received communion, continue driving straight and exit the driveway onto Rt. 8.

St. Stanislaus Kostka Outdoor Communion Flow
Please enter the driveway between the St. Stan's Rectory and the Convent from Hoosac St. Eucharistic Ministers will be positioned near the garage. Once you have received communion, continue along the driveway and exit onto Summer St.
