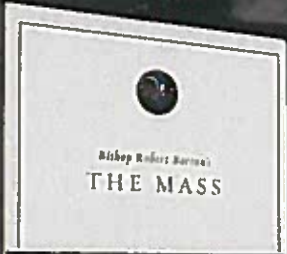

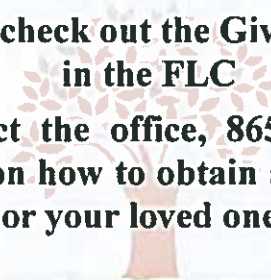
### POST ABORTION HEALING OPPORTUNITIES
