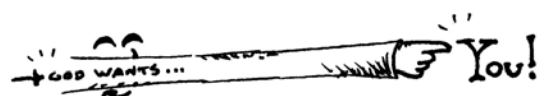
## Did you miss the Sacrament of Confirmation?

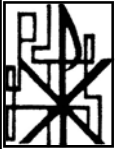
