From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

The month of November is known best in the Catholic world as the month of all saints and all souls. It is a time for the community of believers to recall the happy memory of those members of our families and acquaintances who have died. Our prayers these days not only recall our interaction with those who shared life in this world with us, but to remember them in prayer that anything which may have been wanting on their soul at the moment of death might be purified to finally and completely gain the prize of heaven. We are reminded in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* that "all who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation, but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven." (art.1030) Sacred Scripture and the Tradition of the Church over the ages speak to this very thought of praying on the part of those who survive their beloved deceased as an expression of "atonement" or "reparation" for the sins they committed in this life.

This explains the tradition we have in remembering the dead at the celebration of the Eucharistic Liturgy and the custom of performing acts of almsgiving and works of penance and charity on behalf of the dead. The Mass prayers at a Catholic funeral or in the way of a memorial Mass capture this thought of praying for the forgiveness of sins for those who have died. One prayer states: "O God, by whose mercy the souls of the faithful find rest, graciously grant pardon for their sins." Another Mass oration expresses, "Whatever sins they committed through the frailty of the flesh during their earthly lives you may in your most tender mercy pardon and wipe away." And even at the time of the prayers offered before death, what many still call "last rites", the Church prays "May

Christ, the true Shepherd, acknowledge you as one of his flock...may he forgive all your sins, and set you among those he has chosen."



I remember as a young boy my parents and grandparents often encouraging me and my siblings to pray for the poor souls in purgatory. This custom still remains a noble and pious act on the part of those who survive their beloved dead. As we have commenced this unique month of the calendar year recalling the happy memory of those who have gone before us in death by our prayers and charitable acts, it is our firm hope that those who need our prayers for their atonement will enter the reign of the kingdom and see God face to face.

May all of those who have been called to the Lord in death this past year from Holy Family and St. Nicholas parishes be granted eternal peace in heaven. And may perpetual light shine upon them. Amen.


