HOMILY

THE RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

After the Homily the Priest questions those to be confirmed. They stand for this Renewal of Baptismal Promises. To each question, those to be confirmed together reply: **I do.**

The Priest gives his assent to the profession by proclaiming the faith of the Church. The gathering of the faithful gives its assent by replying.

Priest: This is our faith. This is the faith of the Church.
We are proud to profess it in Christ Jesus our Lord.

People: **Amen.**

THE LAYING ON OF HANDS

The Priest invites the people to pray in silence for a while.

Then the Priest lays hands over all those to be confirmed and says:

Priest: Almighty God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
who brought these your servants to new birth
by water and the Holy Spirit,
freeing them from sin:
send upon them, O Lord, the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete;
give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding,
the spirit of counsel and fortitude,
the spirit of knowledge and piety;
fill them with the spirit of the fear of the Lord.
Through Christ our Lord.

Response: **Amen.**

THE ANOINTING WITH CHRISM

Each of those to be confirmed goes to the Priest; or, if appropriate, the Priest goes to each of those to be confirmed. [If circumstances permit,] the sponsor who presents the person to be confirmed places his/her right hand on the shoulder of the person to be confirmed and says the name of the one to be confirmed to the Priest; or the one to be confirmed alone says his/her own name.

Priest: **N., BE SEALED WITH THE GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.**

Newly confirmed: **Amen.**

Priest: Peace be with you.
Newly confirmed: **And with your spirit.**

PREPARATION FOR COMMUNION

Before saying "Behold the Lamb of God", the Priest may briefly remind the newly confirmed of the preeminence of the Eucharist, which is the climax of Christian initiation and the center of the whole Christian life. For some of the newly confirmed, this celebration also marks the occasion of their first reception of Holy Communion.

Priest: Behold the Lamb of God,
behold him who takes away the sins of the world.
Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

People: **Lord, I am not worthy
that you should enter under my roof,
but only say the word
and my soul shall be healed.**

COMMUNION CHANT

As the Priest receives Holy Communion, the Communion Chant is begun:

One Bread, One Body

Gather 813

Refrain: **One bread, one body, one Lord of all,
one cup of blessing which we bless.
And we, though many, throughout the earth,
we are one body in this one Lord.**

woman or man... no more. (refrain)**

3. **Grain for the fields, scattered and grown,
gathered to one... for all. (refrain)**
