We will collect personal care items to be placed in the Ludington Care's boxes around town to help families in need. The third organization we will help is Lakeshore Food 4 Kids. This organization packages food for students in need and sends the food home with the students over the weekend so they have food to eat. We will collect specific food items for this group. In addition, we will have our annual Kids-N-Cops Dodgeball for a Cause on Tuesday, March 10. The monetary proceeds from this game will go to Lakeshore Food 4 Kids.
