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St. Francis of Assisi Parish School, in partnership with parents, is committed to providing a strong educational foundation emphasizing traditional Catholic spirituality, teachings and values.

Registration for the 2021-2022 school year is now open!

The Archdiocese of Portland Department of Catholic Schools has implemented changes to ensure consistency throughout the entire diocese. To align with the Archdiocese plan, we will be implementing recommended registration changes.

Current school families will be automatically re-enrolled, and the registration fee for the 2020-2021 school year will be applied to family accounts on January 1, 2021. Registration fees will be \$200 per child in grades k-8 if paid in full by February 1. Registration fees will increase to \$275 per child in grades k-8 on March 1, 2021. If a current family wants to delay re-enrollment, they must notify the school office by February 1, 2020.

Scrip awards for the 2021-2022 school year will be applied to tuition up to \$200 per child. Preschool does not participate in Scrip rewards towards registration. Please contact the school office if you have questions.

It is the goal of St. Francis of Assisi Parish and the Archdiocese of Portland that no child whose family is participating in the life of their Parish will ever be denied a Catholic education because of financial need. The Archdiocese of Portland is partnering with St. Francis of Assisi School and FACTS to conduct financial need analyses. Registration through FACTS **must be in by February 1, 2021**, to align with the Archdiocese of Portland grant timelines. St. Francis of Assisi School and the Archdiocese of Portland will award tuition assistance scholarships on a first-come, first-served basis and is a supplement to your family's financial contribution to your child's tuition.

There is a \$35 application processing fee for each family seeking assistance through FACTS.

Our tuition assistance committee will notify you via email of your scholarship award. You will be asked to accept or decline your scholarship assistance award formally. To ensure that your first tuition payment will reflect your award, please complete and submit your FACTS Grant & Aid application on time. The Archdiocese of Portland is asking families to please submit by February 1, 2021.
