Diácono y ministro Hispano en medio de una Iglesia con muchas culturas.



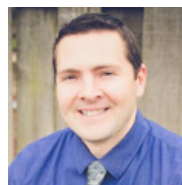
**Hna. Bernadette Wilson** nació y creció en Portland, Oregon y es una Hermana
