Sacramental Preparation and Faith Formation Requirements and Expectations for 2020-2021

- 1) Family needs to be registered in St. Joseph Parish. Please fill out a registration form if needed.
- 2) Parents will meet with Coordinator throughout the year. Date and time TBA.
- 3) Registration fee is \$60.00 to cover the costs of resources. Payment is due at time of registration and is non-refundable.
- 4) A copy of the child's Baptismal certificate needs to be presented at time of registration (usually done during first year)
- 5) Children and parents must follow the safety measures to avoid spread of Covid virus, given by the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon, this includes, but is not limited to use of facemasks, hand sanitizer and keep a safe distance. Child must stay home when sick or feeling sick, and please notify Coordinator.

Please read and initial the following requirements and expectations.

_____ **Regular Sunday Mass attendance is absolutely necessary** and is of greatest importance so that your child may experience God's life-changing presence and love in the greatest way possible.

_____ I understand that as a parent, my role in the catechetical formation of my child, through my words, actions, and example provided is **IRREPLACABLE and EXTREMELY IMPORTANT.** When is once again possible, parents will be expected to stay for classes at the same time their children are receiving their catechesis and will need to keep weekly attendance. But, for now because of all the restrictions and because of limited space available parents will have limited number of meetings. Date and time TBA.

_____ **A child who misses more than 4 times in attending Sacramental Preparation classes may result in having him or her repeat that year of formation.**

_____ If a child displays inappropriate manners like using hurtful or rude words, disrespecting the teacher or another child, taking things that do not belong to them, he or she will be given a warning. If a second offense occurs, the child's parents will be called and a parent will need to attend class with the child.

_____ The children need to be to class on time. Classes start at 10:00am and end at 11:00am. Please come to the main entrance of Gymnasium on the first day of catechesis to be place in your group.

_____ **Because we want to keep our children as safe as possible, the children must be picked up at their classroom by their parents or parental approved person on time. Children will not be released from their classrooms until a parent or appropriate guardian has picked them up.**

_____ Children and parents will follow the safety measures to avoid spread of Covid, given by the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon, this includes, but is not limited to use of facemasks, hand sanitizer and keep a safe distance with others. Child must stay home when sick or feeling sick, and notify Coordinator.
