Youth and Parent Conduct Agreement

I, the undersigned, understand that I have the responsibility to abide by the rules, regulations, and instructions that are provided for any organized activity.

1. Respect of yourself and others – always dress and carry yourself with dignity and modesty. Please refrain from language and clothing that is suggestive, derogatory, and/or rude.

Disrespect of peers and catechists will not be tolerated and will result in a meeting with parents, youth and members of the pastoral staff.

Honor the time of your peers and catechists by arriving to sessions and events on time and are picked up at stated dismissal times and locations. Continual tardiness will not be tolerated and an absence of 4 weekly gatherings and/or 1 of the monthly sacramental preparation sessions will result in having to repeat that year of sacramental preparation.

Please make note of all registration deadlines, fees, and assignment due dates – failure to turn in requested information and fees on time will result in youth not attending event and/or dismissal from Sacramental Preparation Program.

2. Respect and good stewardship of building and property.

This includes, but is not limited to cleaning up after one's self (throwing garbage in the trash cans), putting materials and furniture to required spaces, and not marking in books, on furniture or walls. Disrespect of building and property will not be tolerated and will result in a meeting with parents, youth and members of the pastoral staff.

3. Follow the safety measures regarding COVID given by the Archdiocese of Portland, such as, use of face coverings, hand sanitizer and keeping a safe distance to prevent the spread of COVID. Youth must stay home when feeling sick and please notify Youth Minister.

I understand these rules, expectations, and instructions are provided to insure the safety, security, well-being, and respect of myself and others. I understand that St. Joseph Catholic Parish, the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon, its employees, and it's representatives will not be held liable if I fail to abide by these rules, expectations, or instructions.
