



Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

As we enter into the Month of May, we especially venerate our Blessed Mother. During this month Christians, both in church and in the privacy of the home, offer up to Mary their hearts in loving homage of prayer and veneration. This Christian custom arose at the end of the 13th century. In this way, the Church was able to Christianize secular feasts celebrated at that time. In the 16th century, Christians became more dedicated to this devotion. The practice of honoring Mary during May has been recommended by the Popes. Pius XII made frequent reference to this devotion. Paul VI wrote an encyclical in 1965, urging Marian devotion to obtain peace. In May, 2002, John Paul II said, "Today we begin the month dedicated to Our Lady, a favorite of popular devotion... I ask that we continue to make the month of May a 'Marian' month, celebrating it with many devout liturgical, catechetical and pastoral initiatives."

On Thursday, May 5th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. It is holy day of obligation whereby Catholics are obliged to participate in Mass. We will celebrate the Vigil of the Ascension on Wednesday at 7:30 PM and on Thursday, at the 9:00 AM Mass in Church.

The Easter message this weekend is "peace." "Peace be with you," Jesus said when He appeared to His disciples on the evening of Easter Sunday. Whenever the Risen Lord appeared, His greeting was always: "Peace be with you. Do not be afraid." Actually, peace was Christ's message throughout His whole life. The Prophet Isaiah called Him the "Prince of Peace." At the Last Supper, Jesus said, "I will give you the gift of my peace. It is not the kind of peace that the world gives you. It is my peace."

What kind of peace does Jesus offer? The peace of Christ is more than the absence of trouble. He does not mean a mere absence of war or noise. Rather, peace or "shalom," the Jewish word, meant freedom from trouble. It meant health, it meant a secure and contented life. Jesus offers the peace which conquers our fears and anxieties. St. Augustine has a beautiful definition of peace. According to him, peace means "serenity of the mind, simplicity of the heart, tranquility of the soul."

The Holy Mass is a celebration of peace, a sign of peace, a source of peace, a treaty of peace. May every house and heart in the world hear the greeting of Christ: "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to vou."

May Christ's peace always reign in our hearts.


