Pastoral Reflection

Dear Parish Family,

Next weekend, February 25-26, is Pledge Weekend for the 2017 Archbishop's Annual Appeal. The appeal is something we do every year, except that last year it was part of the Living Stones Capital Campaign, but is back again this year. We do this appeal every year because the needs are ongoing and it is our opportunity to share the gifts God gave us. The theme of the 2017 Sharing God's Blessing Annual Appeal is "Be of One Mind."

In this Year of Missionary Discipleship, we are called to remember that we are all Missionaries and that we have a responsibility to bring others to Christ; helping them to encounter the fullness of love and leading them to discipleship. In order to reach out to our brothers and sisters in Christ, we must "be of one mind: share each other's troubles with mutual affection; be compassionate and humble". When we show sympathy, compassion and humility in our hearts, and equally important, in our actions towards others, we are truly able to become the Missionaries that we are called to be. The Annual Appeal is one concrete way in which we show that we are Missionaries.

There is also a spiritual benefit to our parish. People are reminded to share their gifts more fully with one another.

As your pastor, I once again appeal to you all to support this great endeavor. It is for a good cause. We are able to help our Archdiocese, and in return help our parish as well.

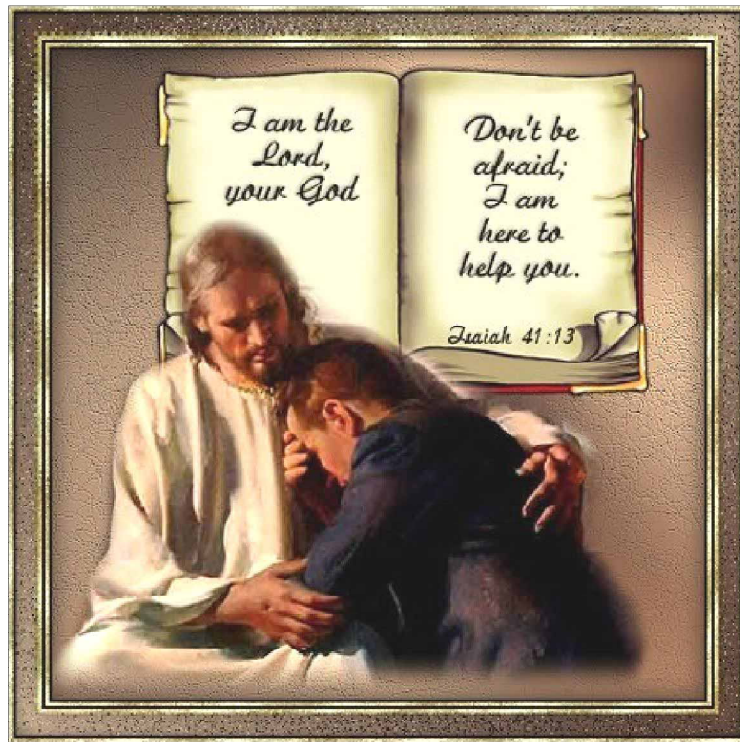
**ST. ANDREW'S MEMORIAL TREE**

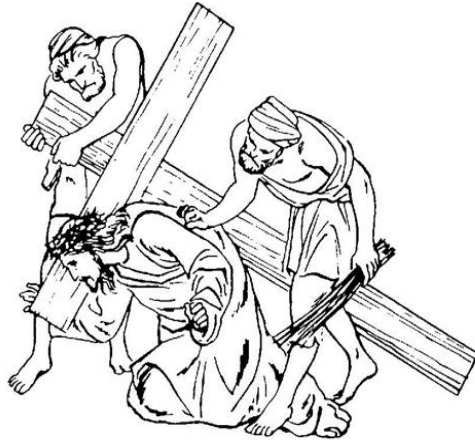
