FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

This is the Fifth Sunday of Lent and next Sunday is Palm Sunday. The central theme of this Sunday's readings is the Resurrection and the Life. All the readings beautifully fit together as they tell us of death yielding to a new way of life. Life and death, hope and despair are the key phrases that sum up the message of this Sunday. In the First Reading, the prophet Ezekiel urges the exiled Israelites in Babylon to look beyond the siege and destruction of Jerusalem to a new future when God's Spirit will restore their nation. God promised them a new life. In the Second Reading, St. Paul reminds Christians that the power of God's Spirit will give life to their mortal bodies. St. John's gospel tells the story of the raising of Lazarus from the dead and being brought back to life, symbolizing that Jesus himself is the Resurrection and the Life. It is said that nothing in life is more certain than death. Yet, many people ask, after death, what? Perhaps the question is raised because death is the end of our plans and aspirations in life or because of the thought of permanent separation from our loved ones or because of the uncertainty about what lies beyond. Maybe we just cannot accept the signs of our mortality. But, Jesus tells us: "I am the Resurrection and the Life." As followers of Jesus, we believe in the resurrection of the dead. Death is not the end of everything, but rather, a passage into eternal life. The only way for Jesus to become our Life and Resurrection is if we die to ourselves.

As we prepare ourselves for the celebration of Holy Week, beginning on Palm Sunday, we should devote time to somber reflection on the events preceding Jesus' death-- His triumphant entry into Jerusalem, His betrayal by Judas, His Last Supper with His twelve apostles, His arrest, crucifixion and death, and His burial in a tomb. Jesus died on the cross for the forgiveness our sins. What an awesome and unfathomable love God has for each one of us. His love for us is beyond measure. What can we give Him in return?

May you all have a meaningful and solemn celebration of Holy Week.
