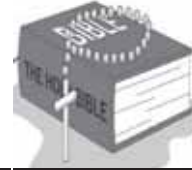

Pastoral Reflection

THE WIDOW'S MITE

"I tell you solemnly, this poor widow has put in more than all who have contributed to the treasury; for they have all put in money they had over, but she from the little she has, put in everything she possessed." (Mk 12:43-44)

The first thing to say about money is that "it is not about the money." Obviously, it isn't the money if Jesus says that the widow's contribution of two cents was worth more than all the large contributions of those who were more wealthy.

It is what we do with the money, or better yet, what the money does to us.

Do you think it is harder to give money away when you are lower middle class or poor, or when you are middle or upper middle class? In the latter, you have more things that need your money? You have more property, more possessions. You are in a position to do more for your children and grandchildren.

The way we spend our money shapes us. What the money does to us is very important. It crafts our spirit. It sculpts us. The way we spend our money shapes the look on our faces, our lips, our whole expression, our soul, our spirit. When we give to the Lord, it makes our spirit richer and our face kinder.

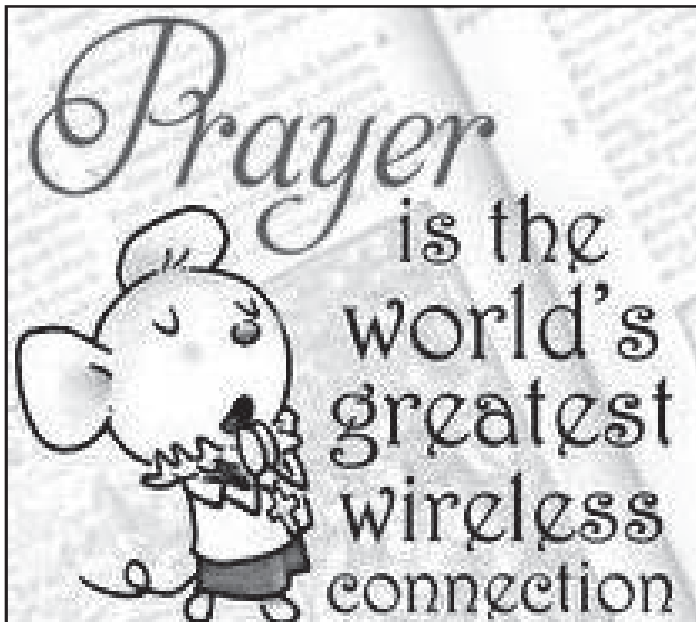
Money is like the woodcarver's blade. You can use it to craft something beautiful, but if you point it at yourself too much, you will disfigure yourself.

Everyone, whether rich or poor, is called to shape themselves in the image of God. For everyone, rich or poor, must craft their soul by reaching out to others in the straight and hard language of money.

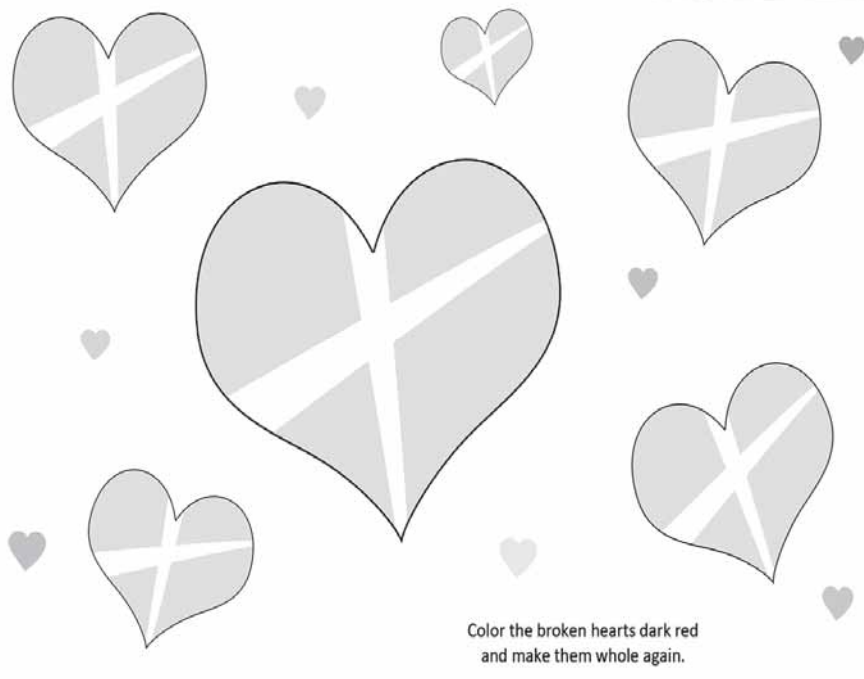
