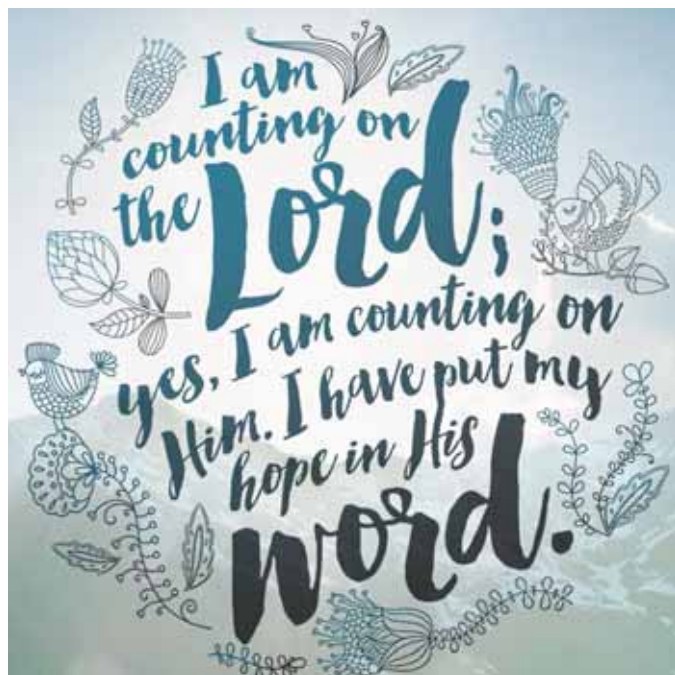

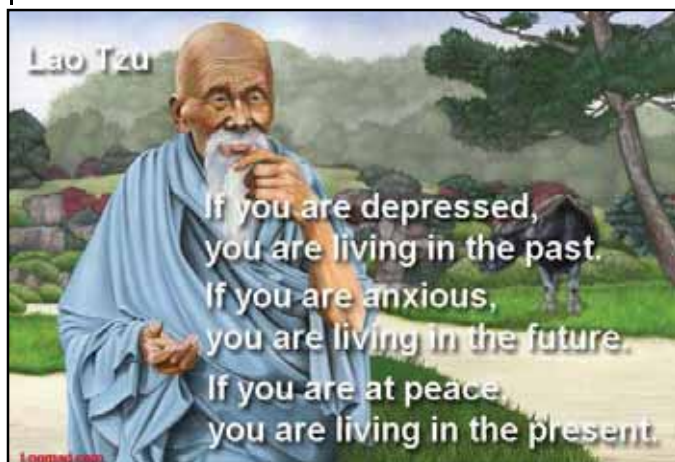


SAVE-THE-DATE A SUMMER FAITH-SHARING SEMINAR

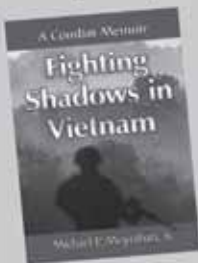

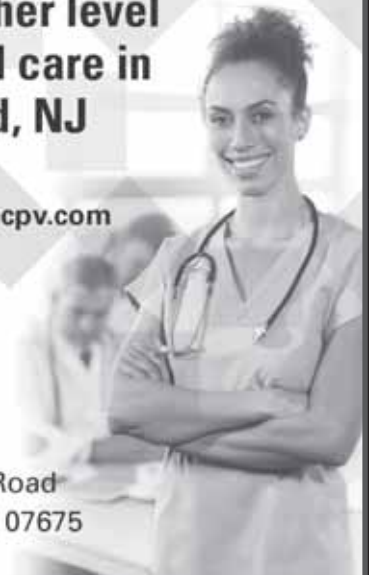
