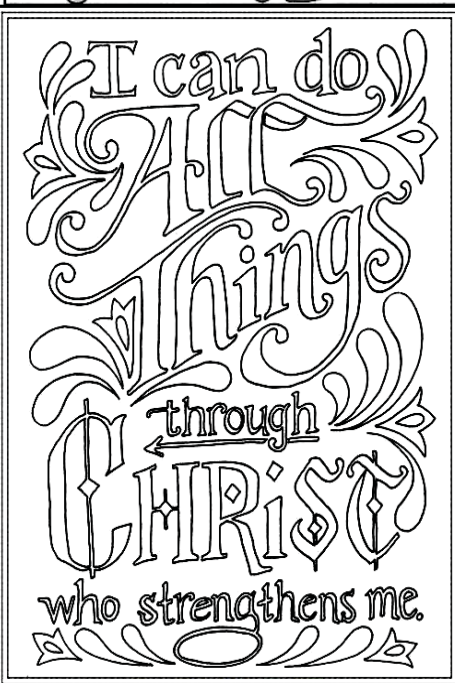
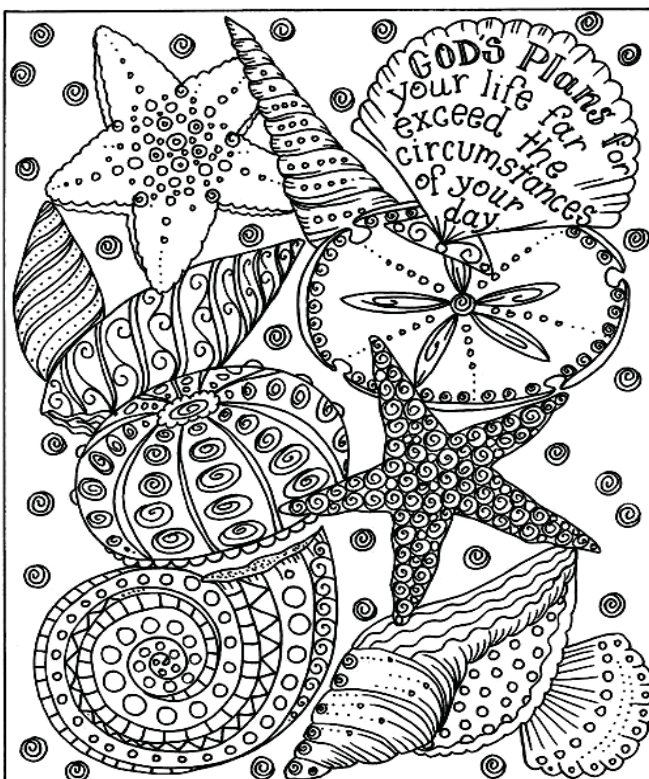

Just want to offer you this day, Lord, a great big Thank you! for your always being there, every time I come to pray...

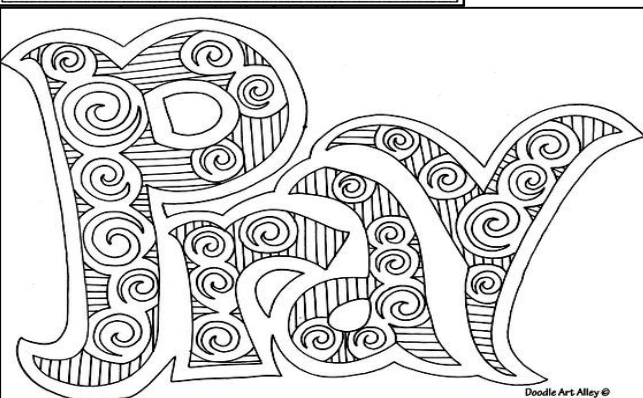

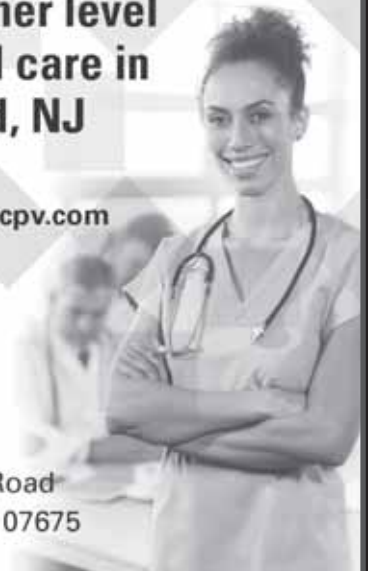
