The first recorded sin in Genesis can be traced to pride. Our society today seems to make us try to be better than the next person, stronger than another nation, richer as we try to get ahead. Where is humility?

Humility is a forgotten virtue. What do I have that is not gift? What have I received that I did not deserve? What have I offered to someone else in need? 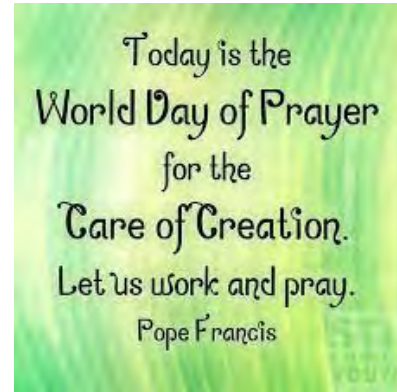
