### Christ Child Piloting Online Sign Up for Volunteering

**Christ Child Society of Cleveland** explored the use of an online sign up tool for volunteering. The tool has many benefits for our organization and the Board decided to pilot it. *Showcase* was selected as the pilot project, and began an online sign up option for June 2021 store volunteers. This pilot, using the SignUpGenius tool, started May 17th.

#### What are your benefits to signing up via SignUpGenius?

- You can match your personal schedule to the available volunteer dates & times.
- You will receive an email confirmation from ChristChildSignUp after typing in your name to fill a time slot.
- You will receive a reminder email two days prior to your volunteer date.
- You will see other members who have signed up, perhaps helpful for planning a carpool.
- This tool will help manage the large number of monthly volunteers for Showcase.

#### What if you cannot use Signup Genius? Can you still call to sign up to volunteer?

Yes, members **always** have the option to call either the Project Chair, a designated person or another Christ Child member to sign up for volunteer activities. For Showcase, call Sharon Hensel or Kathy Cole, if you prefer.

#### How do I sign up online? Here are the step-by-step directions:

1. Please read Christ Child emails for opportunities to volunteer.
2. Click on the link in the email. This will take you to the Christ Child SignUp volunteer activity.
3. Scroll down to view and select the date(s) and shift(s) you want to volunteer by selecting the box in the sign up button.
4. Click the "Submit and Sign Up" tab at the bottom which automatically takes you to another page.
5. On the new page, enter your first and last name and email address. Be sure to add a comment located at the top, if you plan to leave before the shift ends or arrive late. For example, "I will leave at 3 PM", or "I will be 15 minutes late".
6. Select the "Sign up Now" button.
7. Congratulations, you are finished signing up to volunteer!
8. You will receive a confirmation email immediately.
9. Two days before your selected volunteer date, you will also receive a "reminder email" from SignUpGenius.
10. You can click on the link in the original email anytime to view, to sign up for additional time slots, or to cancel.
11. Please remember, if you cancel your spot, as a courtesy, please notify the Project Chair, Kathy Cole or the designated person, Sharon Hensel by email or phone so they can find a replacement for your date and time.
12. Please ignore the advertising and "X" out of the promotions in the right upper corner of ads. Sorry, but these ads appear to pay for the free services!

The committee members are **Robbie Wolan, Colleen Wyszynski, and Julie Jerdonek**. Colleen and Robbie set up the online SignUpGenius for Showcase, and will set up future volunteer sign ups after the pilot is completed and approved. Julie helps with coordination.

# God is Good All the Time

Joanne Saporito's generosity to the Christ Child Society knows no bounds! Joanne, Christ Child member since 1998, extended a warm and gracious welcome to our beloved Bishop Emeritus Roger Gries and Christ Child women at her home for an intimate luncheon. Joanne was one of hundreds who virtually attended The 2020 Starlight Soiree, our major annual fundraiser, winning the auction for An Afternoon with Bishop Roger Gries and Catering by the Taste of Excellence. Great conversation and champagne cocktails preceded a delicious meal of Jack Daniels grilled salmon and beef tenderloin with grilled and chilled vegetables.

Bishop Roger blessed us with his presence and led us in prayer for the Christ Child children living in poverty and all those in need. He inspired us with his personal story and call to become a Benedictine monk. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1963 and for 37 years served at Benedictine High School as a teacher, principal, president and 20 years as the Abbot. About the time he was making his plans for retirement, he responded to an urgent phone call from Bishop Pilla, who summoned him "downtown" ASAP. Without hesitation, he was there and learned Pope John Paul II had invited him to become an Auxiliary Bishop of Cleveland. He again answered God's call for twelve more years of service as our Bishop. Although Bishop Roger "retired" eight years ago, he continues spreading God's love for His people throughout the Diocese of Cleveland as a spiritual shepherd and teacher, celebrating Mass and administering the sacraments, and reaching out to countless longtime friends who cherish his presence, conversation, storytelling and down to earth humor.

Thank you Joanne for your hospitality, your generous and longtime support of Christ Child Society, and opening your lovely home to beloved Bishop Roger and women of Christ Child in support of our mission to challenge childhood poverty.
