Helen Keller's indwelling God?

The story is told that after Helen Keller's teacher, Annie Sullivan, had given her the names of physical objects in sign language, Miss Sullivan attempted to explain God and tapped out the symbols for the name "God." Much to Miss Sullivan's surprise, Helen spelled back, "Thank you for telling me God's name, Teacher, for He has touched me many times before." How could Helen Keller have known about God? Although she was blind and deaf, Helen Keller knew God, for God had shown Himself to her. That is "revelation" of an indwelling God about today's Scripture readings speak.

Why don't you love God Who created you with evesight and strong limbs?" That is what Jesus tells us in today's Gospel. If we love him because of the countless blessings he has given us by "keeping his words" he will start dwelling within us in the company of his Father and the Holy Spirit, making us the temples of the triune God.
