'Namaste'

The poem *The Old Interior Angel* by David Whyte tells the story of a strong, confident young man hiking in the Himalayas who comes to a broken footbridge, dangling hundreds of feet above a rocky stream. The cables have snapped and the wooden planks tumble together uselessly. Clearly, he can go no further. He sits down and tries to talk himself into approaching the trembling, ruined bridge, but cannot bring himself to cross. Admitting defeat, he decides to turn back.

Just as he is about to leave, an old mountain woman, bent and barefoot, an enormous basket balanced on her back, is collecting dung for fuel along the path. Seeing the young man, she smiles and offers the traditional greeting, "Namaste, I greet the God in you."

The young man bows in response, but before he looks up again, she is gone, straight across the crumbling bridge that seemed to him so impassable. Without thinking, swept in the wake of her courage and trust, he says "Namaste" and follows across.
