**1<sup>st</sup> reading, 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16**

**Elisha Raises the Shunammite's Son**

Elisha wanted to thank the Shunammite woman for **all this care and hospitality** she had shown him and his servant. The absence of children in the OT was interpreted as a curse or, at best a sign of shame. And with **no son**, she would likely end up impoverished once her **husband** died.

The woman from Shunem is the kind of person who values the prophet as a spokesman for God. The author introduces her as **“a great woman.”** Elisha often had been a guest in her home. All that time she had been observing the prophet, looking for signs that he was the man of God he professed to be.

At this point in her story the woman has already declined any gift from the king or his officers. She is not seeking material benefits but only spiritual ones. And so when Elisha offers her what only God could give – a child – she accepts.

**Like the woman who helped Elisha, we can become people who minister to the spread**

**of God's word before we think of what's in it for us.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> reading, Romans 6:3-4, 8-11**

**By Baptism we are united to Christ in his death and resurrection.**

Paul's fundamental meaning here is the identification of the believer with Christ as pictured through baptism into the body of Christ at the moment of conversion. Water baptism, the public mark of faith in God, is symbolic of personal, vital identification with Christ.

**The Gospel of Matthew 10: 37-42**

**Christ Brings Division!**

Christ ultimately came to earth to bring peace, but when people choose to follow Jesus, they will often face division and conflict, even within their own house-holds. To choose loyalty to family over loyalty to Christ disqualifies a person from being one of His disciples.

**We get somewhere in our life when we keep our entire attention focused on the gospel, not on ourselves.**

**Jesus invites us today to focus on a discipleship that offers itself to the spread of the gospel mission without counting the costs. For that, we need to exercise our charity.**

**In the exercise of our hearts, we can actually “get somewhere.”**

**Jesus gives everything he is so that we can give everything we are. The Eucharist is not just about the Body of Christ, but about becoming what it signifies: a self-gift for a world that needs the love it offers.**

**Let's give it all it all we've got.**

“Our Father, who has set a restlessness in our hearts and made us seekers after that which we can never fully find, keep us at tasks too hard for us, that we may be drawn to you for strength.”
