THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Jesus called God his Father, but did so in a special way, Jesus called his Father “Abba”, an Aramaic word, which means something like our “Daddy”. (Aramaic was the language in Palestine at the time of Jesus). So now we do not look on God as distant from us.
