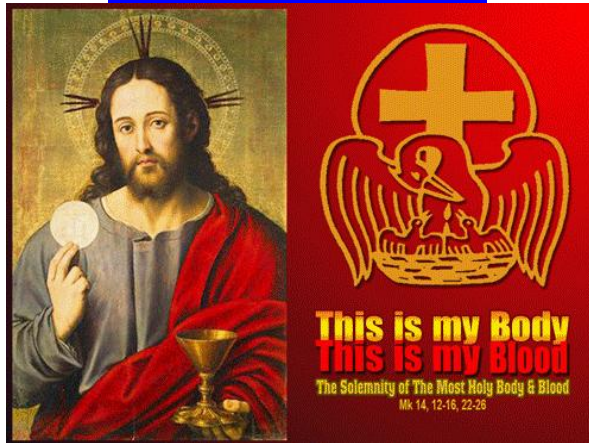

No one has trodden on your head, or on your tongue; it is above in safety, no harm come to it, and yet, because of the bond of love, there just as the tongue, which no one has touched, says, "You are standing on my foot," so Christ, whom no one has touched, says, "I was hungry, and you gave me food."

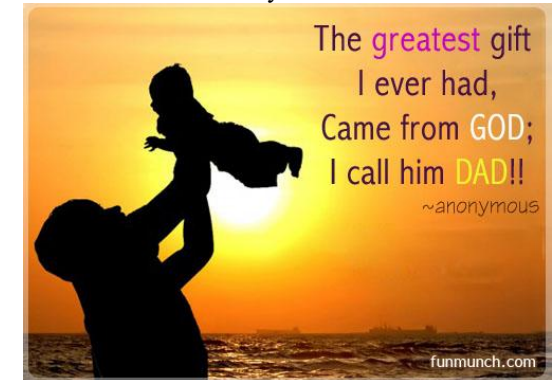
