Christopher Escobedo (Left) is 22 years old. He was born in Roseburg, Oregon. His favorite scripture is Psalm 43:5 *"Why are you downcast, my soul? Why do you groan within me? Wait for God, for I shall again praise him, my savior and my God."*

At sixteen years old, I had a deep inclination to go to church even though I felt I had everything I needed inside I was missing something and I believe Jesus led me to the Catholic Church. When I was 20, missionaries came to my parish and invited me to a retreat. At the retreat, I felt His call for me to do something more, not just for myself, but also to serve others."

Alan Guerrero (Right) is 24 years old. He was born in Bloomington, California. His favorite bible text is Jeremiah 1:4-5 *"The word of the Lord came to me: Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you, before you were born, I dedicated you, and a prophet to the nations I appointed you."*

He says, "During my whole life, I felt that I was looking for something to fulfill emptiness in my heart. I have always been Catholic, but as I grew up, my faith was decreasing. I didn't know much about God or my Catholic faith. When the missionaries came to my parish, I felt an interest growing in my heart and mind. They invited me to Youth Group. In the first meeting, I heard the verse from Jeremiah and my mind was blown away. I felt a fire in my heart that filled the emptiness I had carried for so long.
