Palm Sunday!!!

Today we find ourselves at Holy Week. Throughout His ministry, Jesus has been suggesting its arrival. Frequently, He said: ***My hour has not come.*** Today, on Palm Sunday, that hour has begun to toll.

In Matthew's Passion, Jesus enters Jerusalem as a rowdy group shouts His praises. Jerusalem, the Holy City. A city where the awareness of the holy has often been intertwined with violence. The plotting high priests are conscious of a troubled atmosphere in the crowds. Jerusalem is a place of intense religious beliefs, a place of dark political conspiracies, a place of group enthusiasms and mob denunciations. ***And when (Jesus) entered Jerusalem the whole city was shaken.*** For most of this Lent, we here in our parish have been shaken. We have so many anxieties, so much to worry about. It has been hard to concentrate on living out Lent. When we look back and evaluate our success in observing prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, we may find we were not focused. Like the exhausted apostles in Gethsemane, we may have hidden in sleep. Jesus knows that our spiritual equilibrium has been threatened by the terrible health disaster we face. ***The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak.***

When Jesus wakens the sleeping apostles, He simply says, ***Get up, let us go.*** We are invited to follow Him to His Hour. He is going to win divine life for us. No matter what our failures, what trials we want to avoid, what crosses we want to reject. He is with us. We must be close to Him and one another. ***Get up, let us go.***

Domingo de Ramos!

Hoy nos encontramos todos en Semana Santa. A lo largo de su ministerio, Jesús ha estado sugiriendo su llegada. Con frecuencia, dijo: ***Mi hora no ha llegado.*** Hoy, el Domingo de Ramos, esa hora ha comenzado a pasar factura.

En la Pasión de Mateo, Jesús entra a Jerusalén cuando un grupo ruidoso grita Sus alabanzas. Jerusalén, la ciudad santa. Una ciudad donde la conciencia de lo sagrado a menudo se ha entrelazado con la violencia. Los conspiradores sumos sacerdotes son conscientes de una atmósfera problemática en las multitudes. Jerusalén es un lugar de intensas creencias religiosas, un lugar de conspiraciones políticas oscuras, un lugar de entusiasmo grupal y denuncias de la mafia. ***Y cuando (Jesús) entró en Jerusalén, toda la ciudad fue sacudida.***

Durante la mayor parte de esta Cuaresma, aquí en nuestra parroquia hemos sido sacudidos. Tenemos tantas ansiedades, tanto de qué preocuparnos. Ha sido difícil concentrarse en vivir la Cuaresma. Cuando miramos hacia atrás y evaluamos nuestro éxito al observar la oración, el ayuno y la limosna, podemos encontrar que no estábamos enfocados. Al igual que los apóstoles cansados en Getsemaní, podemos habernos escondido en el sueño. Jesús sabe que nuestro equilibrio espiritual ha sido amenazado por el terrible desastre de salud que enfrentamos. ***El espíritu está dispuesto, pero la carne es débil.***

Cuando Jesús despierta a los apóstoles dormidos, simplemente dice: ***Levántense, vámonos.*** Estamos invitados a seguirlo hasta su hora. Él va a ganar la vida divina para nosotros. No importa cuáles sean nuestros fracasos, qué pruebas queremos evitar, qué cruces queremos rechazar. El esta con nosotros. Debemos estar cerca de Él y los unos de los otros. Levántense, vámonos.
