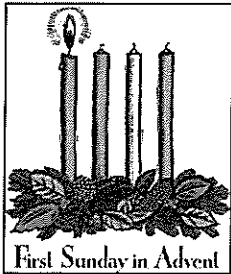

Temporary Data Entry Clerk(s)

The Diocese of Stockton, Office of Development and Stewardship is seeking to hire (2-3) full-time or part-time temporary data entry staff to assist with the 2022 Bishop's Ministry Appeal at the Pastoral Center Office in Stockton. The ideal candidates will have high attention to detail, strong accuracy, and data entry experience. Being bilingual (English/Spanish) is preferred.

The data entry positions are responsible for updating and maintaining the donor database management system for the Diocese of Stockton. Clerks process daily confidential gifts and enter donor information into the database with precision and accuracy in accordance with our Gift Processing Procedures.

The work schedule is 20 - 35 hours per week between the hours of 8:30 am – 4:30 pm, Monday through Friday from approximately mid-February through April 2022 (depending on workload).

Here are the guidelines received from the Diocese that we will be following regarding masks (7/29/2021):

San Joaquin County says that "fully vaccinated people are ***strongly recommended*** to take the extra precaution of wearing a mask indoors."

People who are ***not fully vaccinated*** are still ***required*** to mask in indoor public settings by State mandate.
