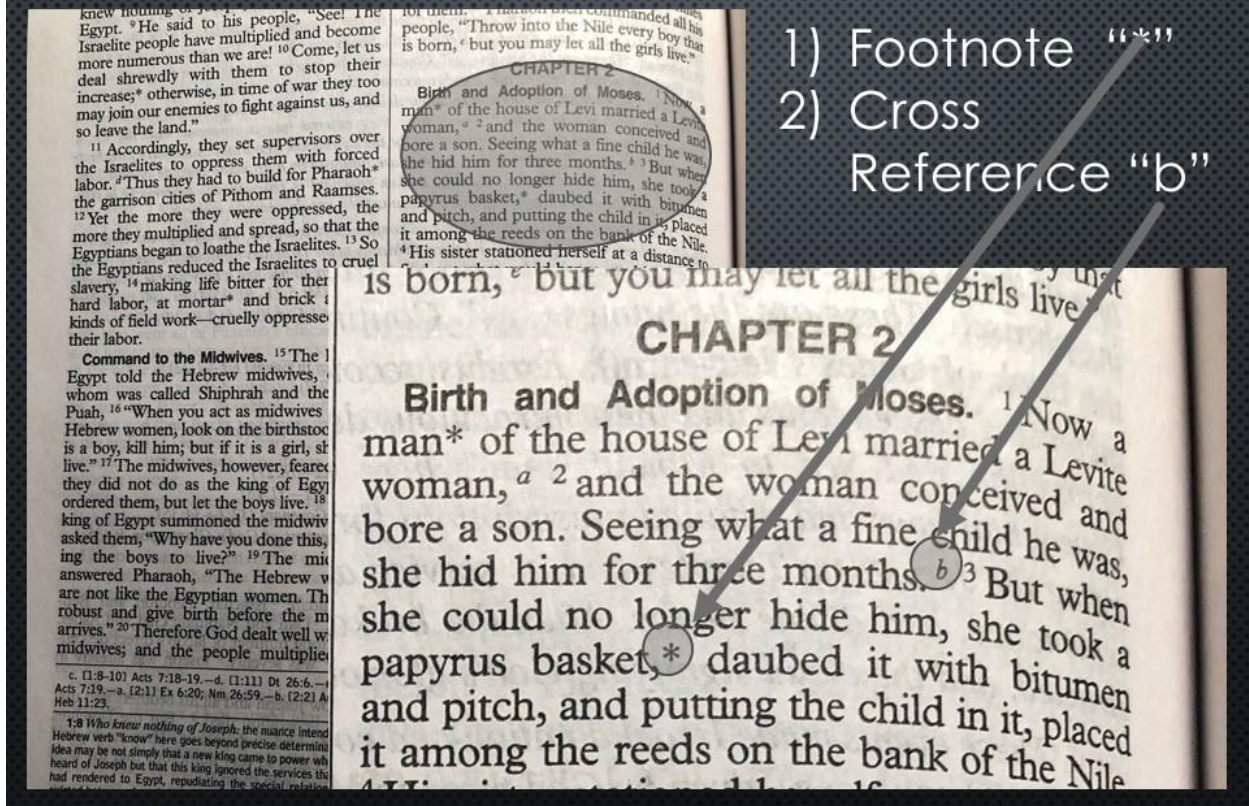


HOW TO READ THE BIBLE

Everybody's at different places. If you have been to a bible class before, you are like "I'm bored". Hang on. I got over this because I get everybody up to the letter. The first is how to read the Bible. It is very important to know the difference between the footnotes and the cross references. The Church has done a lot of studying already for you to help you along the way.

The footnotes are found in the little stars. So when you are reading and you come across a little star. I'm reading Chapter 2, The Birth and Adoption of Moses. And then I come across this little star(*) to the footnote. And then I also come across these letters, (a, b, c, d, e, f, g). If

you look, you see the little *b* “she hid him for three months”. And then there is verse 3 and then I come to a *. That’s when I am going to say “Look at the footnote” and you’ll know that I am looking at the star and I will say look at the cross reference.
