POLICY UPDATES

The Advent of the new Missal with its re-translated GIRM has required the updating of most of our liturgical policies and liturgy preparation forms. Most of the changes involve updating GIRM quotes and liturgy options to reflect the new texts.

A couple of our policies have been significantly revised:

1. We have revised the policy on Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to include a section on safe environment training for those bringing communion to those at home or in health care institutions.
2. We have updated the policy on the extraordinary form of the Mass to reflect the new Instruction from the Vatican.
3. We have taken all our Confirmation policies and brought them together into a single compendium for ease of access and use.

Hard copies of the policies will be provided to the priests at the November clergy gathering. They will also be posted on our website come Advent.

MISSAL SHIPMENTS

Publishers have started to ship missals. As they arrive, we need to sort them and generate invoices. As soon as a parish's (or individual's) shipment is ready, we will let you know. At that point:

1. You can make arrangements to pick them up.
2. If there are chancery staff travelling to the deaneries, we will send the missals for that deanery along with them.
3. Any remaining missals will be brought to the November clergy gathering for distribution.
