## Application Deadline is February 22, 2019

**Who?** Any U.S. Catholic with an interest in solidarity building, participation of the poor, and Catholic Social Teaching. Spanish-speaking preferred but not required.

**What?** Intern will work with one local CCHD funded group: Quad Cities Interfaith, Davenport or Center for Worker Justice, Iowa City or the Diocese of Davenport, Social Action Office. Tasks will vary but may include: parish education, training and outreach, letter and article writing, research, and developing relationships with community organizations and the Hispanic Community. The internship is 16-20 flexible hours per week for 24 weeks during the school year paid at \$14.00/hour.

**When?** 2019/2020 school year. Intern must be able to attend the May 29 -31, 2019 CCHD Training. (Expenses paid).
